officials in all municipalities concerned must be supportive of the concept, and appropriate mechanisms should be established to ensure their continued involvement in this commission if and when it is established.

There are, in the economic climate of the 1980s, no quick fix solutions to our unemployment situation (with the single exception of the much-needed federal assistance we have applied for to help reopen the RCA plant in Midland). Rather we need to develop a concerted, long-term strategy of industrial promotion that ensures co-operation among the municipalities. Here, the process of developing a strategy is almost as important as the strategy itself. For unless the municipalities work in concert, with a sound, articulated policy and set of procedures agreed to in advance, any co-operation is likely to be short lived and of dubious benefit.

RECOMMENDATIONS
That Penetanguishene and Midland form a small, joint working committee with 1 elected and 1 appointed representative from each municipality, with the mandate to research and begin developing a long-term industrial strategy for the area, and to report back to both councils on the progress no later than the end of December, 1983.

That this Committee be specifically directed to include the other four municipalities in the area—Tiny and Tay Townships, Port McNicoll and Victoria Harbour—to invite them to appoint two members each to this working committee on the same basis as Midland and Penetanguishene.

That the working committee proceed to develop its strategy with the representatives from those municipalities that wish to take part and that it proceed to fulfill its mandate regardless of the level of participation from these municipalities.

That this Committee draw up, if necessary, a modest budget for research and other operating expenses as deemed appropriate for submission to the participating municipalities within two (2) months of its formation.

That such monies as to be paid to the Committee be allocated by participating municipalities on the basis of an equalized assessment formula.
