

Reeve speaks well of new councillor

Harry Hunt, Tiny Township's new councillor, is the "type of person who can move in and you will think that he has been here for years," in the opinion of Township reeve Morris Darby.

Hunt was sworn at Wednesday's meeting of township council, and takes the chair left vacant by the sudden death of Ralph Mertz. Hunt has been on the township's planning

board for a year.

A teacher and principal in York County for 18 years, Hunt moved to Tiny Township 11 years ago when he bought the Wyevale Mill, which he ran for five years. School students, mostly from the metropolitan Toronto area, came to the mill to study nature.

Five years ago Hunt bought a hobby farm on Concession 4. He is also a real

estate agent with the Elmvale office of A.E. LePage. He was raised on a dairy farm.

After he was sworn on Wednesday the new councillor said that he realized that he has a tough job to fill, and that he thinks that he will be fortunate if he gets the respect that his predecessor had.






