

2.2 million gallons water, water and more water being used during heat wave

There's no denying it, Midland-Penetanguishene is in the middle of a heat wave.

Midland PUC General Manager Art Evans can tell you all about heat waves. He confirmed yesterday, water users in town used 2.2 million gallons of water on Wednesday.

"About one million was used between 5 p.m. and 11 p.m.," Evans confessed.

Usually about 1.6 million gallons of water is used in Midland in any given 24-hour period.

You might be interested in knowing, it takes about a ton (1,000 gallons) of water to sprinkle one lawn.

And speaking of sprinkling lawns...Evans reminds Midland home-owners the town's water restriction bylaw is in force.

That means users may water their lawns on odd calendar days if their addresses are odd-numbered. Those with even-numbered homes are to sprinkle their lawns on even-numbered days.

Injured rushed to PGH after crash

A 22-year-old Unionville woman was charged early yesterday morning by Midland OPP with careless driving as a result of a two-car crash on Champlain Road in Tiny Twp.

OPP report, Tamalyn Mashinter, the driver, and her 20-year-old passenger from Oshawa, Drew Dusome, were injured after the Unionville driver's car is said to have struck a parked car while Mashinter was negotiating a curve.

Mashinter was slightly injured while Dusome received serious injuries.

Both were transported by ambulance to Penetanguishene General Hospital for treatment following the 1:50 a.m. mishap.

Volunteer firemen the rule

Penetanguishene's fire department is one of 503 fire departments in the province without any fulltime firemen. Out of 637 fire departments in the province, only 34 have a fulltime staff.

One hundred more departments, including Midland, have a core of fulltime firemen and a number of volunteers to fill the roster.

There are 241 municipalities which buy fire protection from neighbours, and 39 municipalities which have no fire protection of any sort.

MEICA wants clear title

Midland town council is considering releasing to Mitsubishi Electronics Industries Canada Inc. (MEICA) a

small section of land which MEICA will get automatically in 1985, unless the town decides to use the land.

Railways gave the land to the town in 1964 on condition that the land would revert to the owner of the land to the west, if unused, after 20 years.

The section, about the size of the Midland council chamber, is a water lot at the north end of MEICA's property.

The land to the west has passed to RCA and now to Meica, which wants to clear its title to its new property.

Part and parcel of the job

Midland Fire Department's Division of Fire Prevention last month conducted three investigations, searched 46 properties for Fire Orders and took part in 11 fire prevention inquiries.

The information was contained in a report prepared by Fire Chief Hal Belfry and tabled at Monday night's town council meeting.

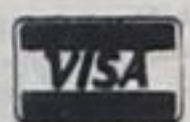
