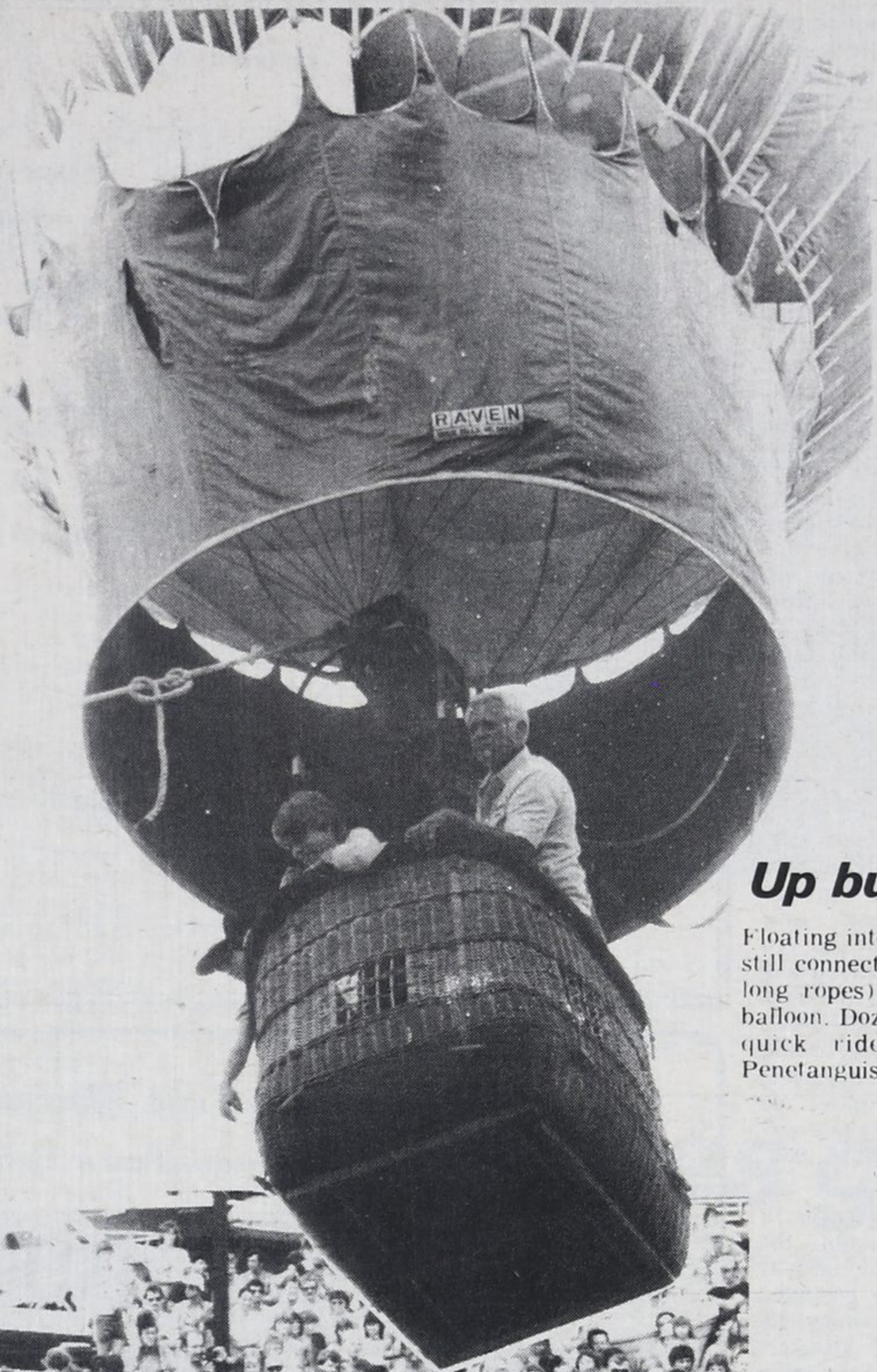

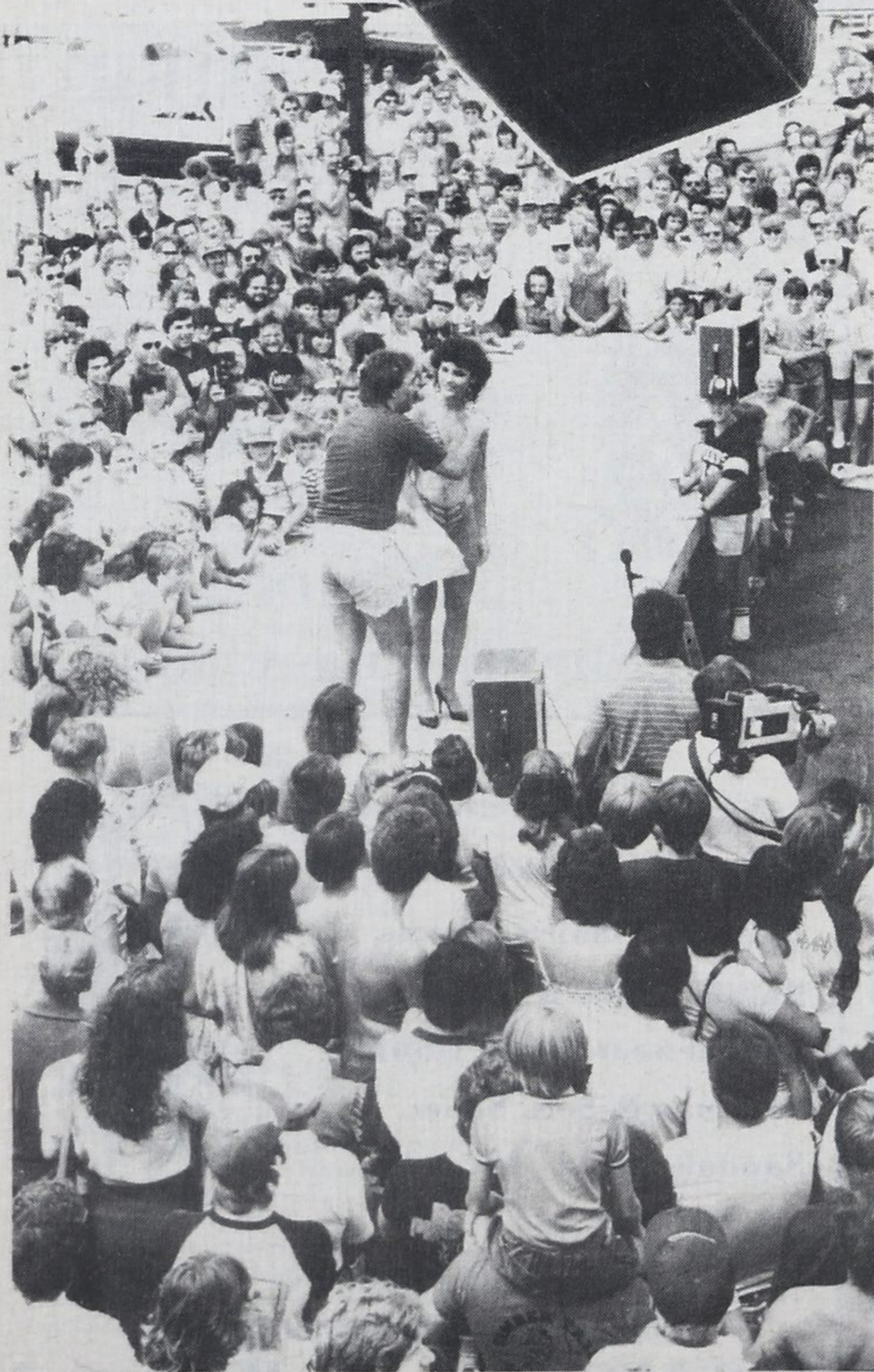
Up but not away
