

Lots to see and do at the Fair

Organizers of the 1983 Elmvale Fall Fair and Home Show have planned a busy three-day calendar of events.

Thursday, Oct. 6 will be devoted to preparing exhibits. Grounds and buildings will be open to directors, members of the various committees, judges and exhibitors. All exhibits except livestock must be on the grounds before 9 p.m.

On Friday, the Fair grounds will be open to the public for livestock exhibits after 8 a.m. Friday is Junior School Fair Day, with a Student Horse and Pony Show, competitions and displays by the students.

The School Parade, complete with floats, bands, antique cars and decorated horses and bikes, will leave HCES at 1 p.m. and travel along Queen Street to the Fair grounds. Special entries in the parade will be the Kalev Estienne Gymnasts and the OPP Golden Helmets.

Also at 1 p.m. on Friday is the 4-H Club Achievement Day, at 2 p.m. the Dog Show, and the Student Horse and Pony Show, and at 3:30 p.m., the 4-H Queen's Guineas, as well as a Midway all day long, needlework and horticultural displays. The Special Baby Show will be held at 2:30 p.m., inside the Arena.

The evening Variety Show will be held in the Arena, starting at 8 p.m. with a performance by the rock band KAOS. Denim, a group of country musicians from Oro, follows at 8:15, and at 8:45 the Miss Elmvale Fall Fair Queen contestants will be introduced.

The winner of the Elmvale Lance Citizen of the Year Contest will be announced at 9:15. At 9:30, a performance by the Kalev Estienne professional gymnastics troupe will be the climax of the variety show.

A Junior Dance will be held at the Elmvale Community Hall on Friday evening, beginning at 9:30 p.m.

On Saturday, grounds will open to the public at 9 a.m., buildings at 12 noon.

The Saturday Parade, a Promenade of Colour,

will begin at 12 p.m. Judging of livestock will take place from 1 to 4 p.m. and at 1:30 the OPP Golden Helmets

will perform. At 2:30, there'll be a horse pull, and of course the Midway will continue all day Saturday.

Inside the Arena, the Legion band will be on stage, starting at 1:15 p.m. The Fall Fair Queen and her prin-

cesses will be crowned at 2:15, KAOS will play again at 3 p.m., and the Kalev Estienne Gym-

nasts will perform at 3:15.

The grand finale of the Fall Fair, a dance at

the Arena, will begin at 9 p.m. at the Arena. Northern Edition will provide the music.

Or you can go on the rides. I hope they have the salt and pepper shaker there.

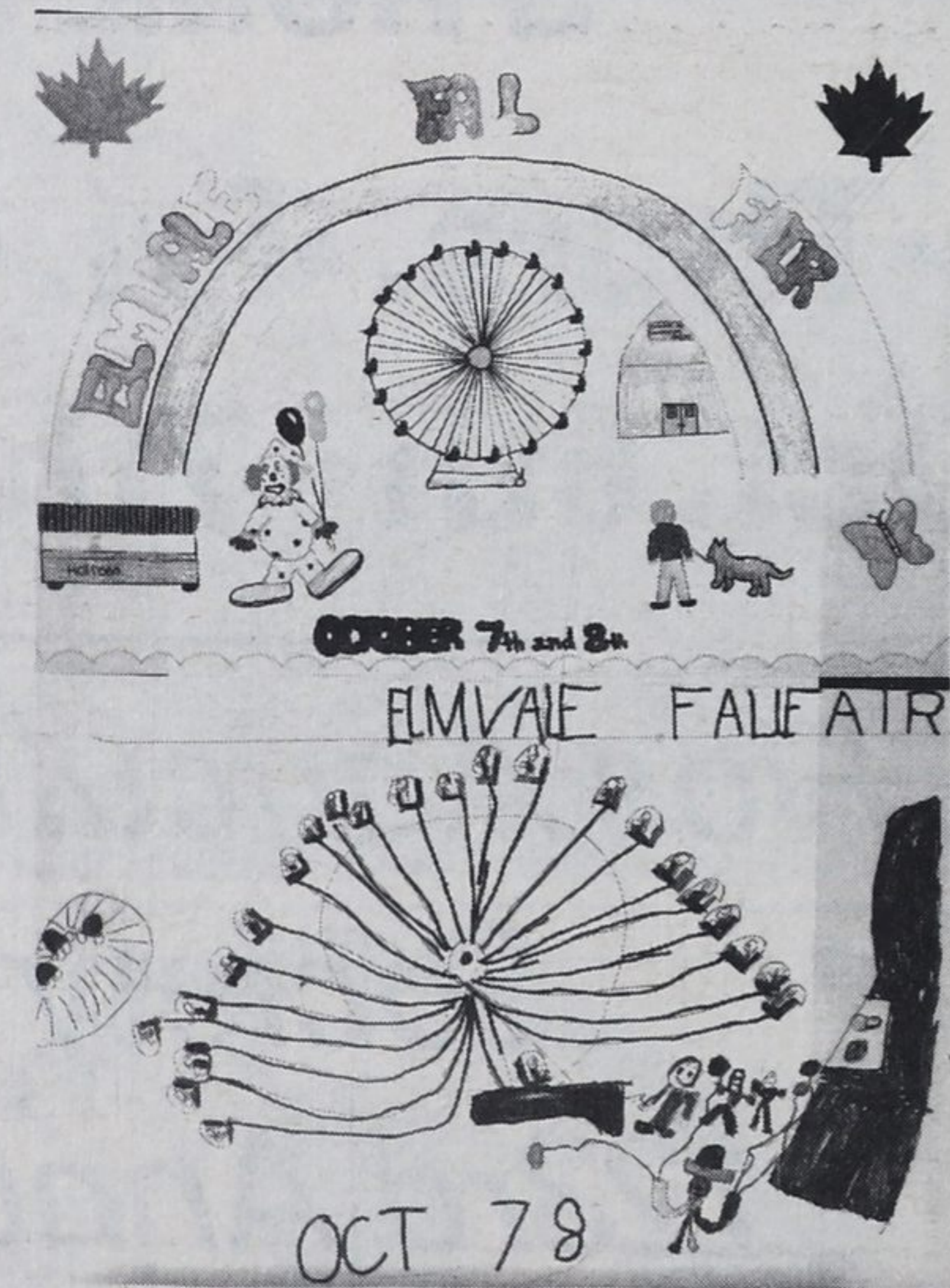
