Ogilvie and aldermen collide when 10 minute limit passed

Midland's mayor used his gavel several times Monday in his attempt to maintain order in Midland's council chamber, during the end of a submission by resident William Ogilvie. Aldermen Miles Blackhurst, Bob Jeffery, and Dan Herbert objected loudly when Ogilvie passed the 10 minute mark of his speech.

The former Midland reeve's subject was the propriety of the Huronia Airport Commission appointing Steve Quaipe to the position of airport manager.

Alderman Jeffery made repeated suggestions to the mayor that Ogilvie be ejected.

Ogilvie complained that some of the four

other deputations which preceded him were allowed over 10 minutes to speak.

The council can, if it chooses, cut off a speaker after 10 minutes.

Inside the Pages Ben-Gurion:

the life of Israel's first leader

Ben-Gurion, Prophet of Fire by Dan Kurzman is a hefty biography of Israel's first leader, David Ben-Gurion, a Polish Jew who emigrated to Palestine as a young man and who, upon achieving leadership, in 1948 went to war against the Arabs. Ben-Gurion remained Israel's leader until 1963. The book contains an account of the driven Ben-Gurion's personal sacrifices as well as a history of the public man. The jacket copy promises the story of his long struggle "to build an exemplary Jewish state, a source of light that would, as Isaiah had prophesized, help to redeem all mankind."

Ben-Gurion, Prophet of Fire includes within its 544 pages 24 pages of photographs, 40 pages of notes, a 22 page bibliography, and a 16 page index.
