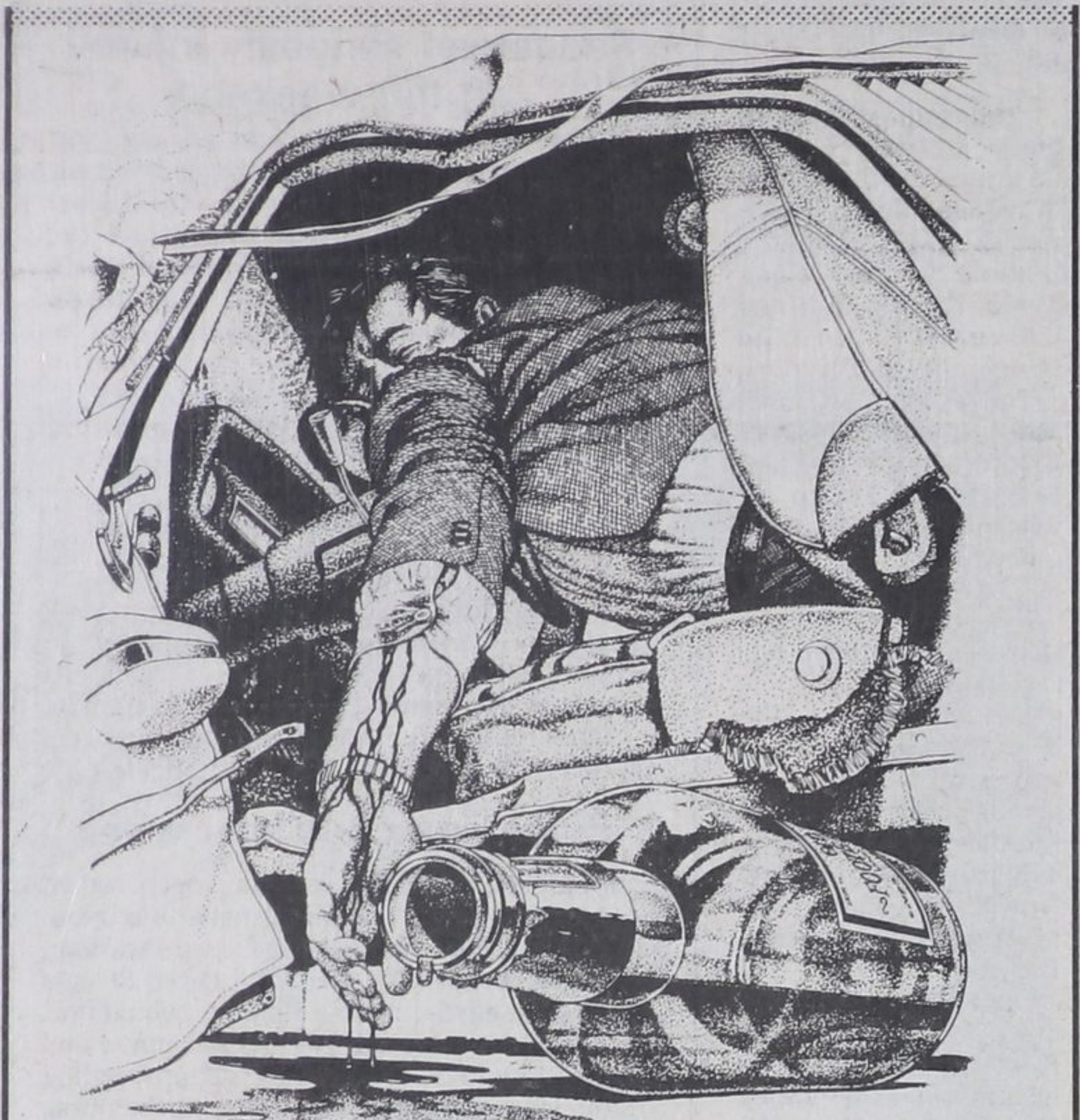

Statistics don't lie. The problem of drunken driving won't go away unless we do something about it. All of us - 7 out of 10 adults in Canada drink alcoholic beverages. Almost all drive. Drunken driving is our nation's number one homicide with approximately 2,000 deaths recorded yearly. This doesn't include the 65,000 related injuries. Drunk driving is the number one killer of Canadians between the ages of 16-24. Surveys indicate drivers in the 30-34 year age bracket had been drinking most often. How can we help stop this un-

necessary horror? We can support and encourage strict drunk driving laws, but moreover, each of us must feel a personal sense of responsibility. Basically everyone who drinks drinks and drives. Reasons for drunk drivers on the road vary: two buddies celebrating a promotion, teenagers trying to be one of the "group", some folks out for a "night on the town". But remember, you or a loved one can become the victim of one of these "nice people" who commit a criminal act by driving under the influence of alcohol. Or, if you drink and drive, you might be the victimizer...the criminal.
