A nine-square km. area within the City of Brampton's northern boundaries has been added to the candidate areas already under consideration, as possibly containing sites for liquid industrial waste treatment facilities, Dr. D.A. Chant, Chairman and President of the Ontario Waste Management ('orporation (OWMC) announced today.

This area is now being considered in the same detail as 19 other candidate areas within the Golden Horseshoe announced by OWMC last May.

tained unsuitable soil conditions were excluded from further consideration.

"We indicated in May, however, that we would be taking a closer look at some of these areas north of Lake Ontlario, stretching from Brampton in the west to Oshawa in the east, to make sure we did not overlook any small parcels of suitable land, particularly industrially-designated land," Dr. Chant explained.

The identification of this new candidate area is the result of this closer, detailed analysis. It contains geologic and Lydrogeologic conditions which may make it

for siting suitable OWMC treatment facilities.

It is located within the northern boundaries of the City of Brampton, and stretches from Highway No. 7 on the east to Mayfield Road on the west (Brampton-Caledon Municipal Boundary).

"I want to stress that this announcement simply adds another candidate area to the 19 already being considered, and is not a site announcement.

Although all or part of this area may be eliminated when further site selection factors are considered, we feel it is only fair to let the public know that we are considering it, together with the other candidate areas already identified," Dr. Chant explained.

OWMC consultants are presently collecting, mapping and analyzing local, regional and provincial data on many site selection factors for each of the 20 candidate areas within the Golden Horseshoe. These factors include local use. tranland sportation, agriculture, environmental and socio-economic considerations.

This process will take several weeks complete, and will result in the announcement of specific candidate sites in a public report. Detailed, on-the-land studies of these sites will then follow, prior to the preparation of OWMC's formal proposals to an independent hearing panel.

OWMC is a provincial crown agency responsible for developing a liquid industrial waste management system for Ontario.
