## PUBLIC MEETING

CONCERNING A PROPOSED  
ZONING BYLAW AMENDMENT

TAKE NOTICE that the Council of the Corporation of the Village of Victoria Harbour will hold a Public Meeting on Thursday, April 5th, 1984, at 1:00 p.m. at the Municipal Office, corner of William and Albert Street, Victoria Harbour, Ontario, to consider a proposed Zoning Bylaw Amendment under Section 34 of the Planning Act. The proposed Zoning Bylaw Amendment includes additions to, and re-wording of, several sections of the text. Further, the proposed Amendment contains changes in land use designations for three properties in the Village. Two of the changes in land use designations are required to have the zoning boundaries as illustrated in schedule "A" to the Bylaw conform to the actual property boundaries. One of these properties is located on Martha Street and the other is located on Albert Street. The other land use designation change is required to recognize the existence of an apartment in a home on St. Mary's Crescent therefore the Residential Second Density designation would be changed to Residential Third Density.

ANY PERSON may attend the public meeting and or make written or verbal representation either in support of or in opposition to the proposed Zoning Bylaw Amendment.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION relating to the proposed Zoning Bylaw Amendment is available for inspection between 8:30 a.m. and 4:30 p.m. at the Village of Victoria Harbour Municipal Offices temporarily located on Richard Street, Victoria Harbour, Ontario.
