

SCBE budget new high of \$139 million

The 1984 budget of the Simcoe County Board of Education is \$139 million, an increase of \$12 million from 1983.

Slightly more than \$100 million of the \$139 million is salaries for over 3,000 board employees.


Joan Jensen, trustee for Penetanguishene and Tiny Township, said yesterday that "the budget is not as high as it started out to be. If the board had acted on all of the wants that the board had, it certainly would have come in a lot higher amount."

The budget passed on Monday is one "more acceptable" to the public, Jensen said.

Homeowners with homes assessed at \$50,000 will pay about \$525 in 1984 to the SCBE, an increase of about \$60, or about 13 percent.



With over 56 years history, 46,000 individual members, and 350 member clubs, the Ontario Federation of Anglers and Hunters is Ontario's largest provincial conservation organization.

In recent years, the OFAH has been recognized for being one of the first, if not the first, major group to draw the dangers of acid rain to the attention of the Canadian and U.S. public.

The OFAH spearheaded action by the Canadian Wildlife Federation and was a founding member of the Canadian Coalition on Acid Rain.

Federation members have been particularly active in stream rehabilitation and clean up, lake reclamation, and walleye and trout rearing.
