#### THE PROHIBITED USE OF MOTORIZED VEHICLES IN WASAGA BEACH PROVINCIAL PARK

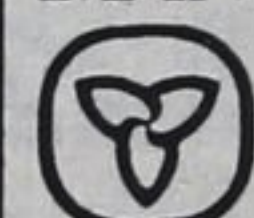
Motorized vehicles including motorcycles and all off-road vehicles as defined under the Highway Traffic Act and Off-Road Vehicles Act are prohibited from operating in the following areas of Wasaga Beach Provincial Park:

- on the beachfront from the mouth of the Nottawasaga River west to 71st Street and east to the Flos Tiny Twp. line.

- in the Dunes Park of Wasaga Beach Provincial Park.

- in all beach Areas except on roadways open to public use.

Violators may be fined a maximum \$500.00 under the Provincial Parks Act and or Public Lands Act by the Ministry of Natural Resources or the Ontario Provincial Police. Further information regarding this matter may be obtained by contacting the Park Superintendent, Wasaga Beach Provincial Park, Box 183, Wasaga Beach, Ontario L0L 2P0.
