## MINDING YOUR MONEY

If you are a parent, you probably worry about providing for your child's education.

One obvious solution is to open some sort of savings account for the youngster and let it accumulate until he or she finishes high school. This is, of course, perfectly feasible, but you should be aware of the tax liabilities on such an account. In general, income

earned on any property, such as money, transferred to a child under 18, is taxable to the person who made the gift. Once the child reaches 18, however, the income becomes taxable to the child. As most 18-year-olds have a low income, the tax would be correspondingly minimal.

No savings in trusts Banks and other

financial institutions offer "trust accounts" for minor children. This is one way of "earmarking" a savings account for the child's However, education. income on these accounts is normally attributed for tax purposes to the person who opens the accountmost likely the parent-rather than to the child. So you have no tax

savings here at all. It is possible to establish a trust for a child in which you loan, rather than give, the money to the trust. The income accumulates tax-free. However, such trusts can only be established with the assistance of a lawyer, and start-up and ad-

In the past, people frequently circumvented taxes by purchasing a Canada Savings Bond or a guaranteed investment certificate for a minor child with a maturing date after the child's 18th birthday. That way, the child would benefit from the income, paying virtually no taxes in most cases.

Laws have changed recently, and the income on these instruments must be reported for tax purposes at least every Northree years. mally, the person giving the gift would be liable. If you live in Quebec, incidentally, you must take care not to run afoul of the gift tax laws in transferring property to children.

You may have heard of Registered Educational Savings Plans (RESP) as one way to educate the child and get a tax break. These plans are available only through a limited number of RESP companies and brokers--banks don't

handle them. Basically, they allow a person to contribute up to \$25,000 on behalf of a child. The capital contribution is not deductible to the donor, but interest or capital gains accumulate interest-free within the plan. When the child begins post-secondary education, he or she can withdraw the accumulated income from the plan for educational and living expenses. The capital goes back to the donor. The withdrawals are taxed to the child, that is, most likely at a very low rate. There are drawbacks

However, there are some serious drawbacks. For one thing, your recalcitrant child decides not to continue education, earnings on all your contributions may be lost, although you will get your capital back.

If you notice early on that the child benefiting from the education fund does not appear particularly studious, and you decide to switch the fund to a more promising offspring, you may find this is not possible.

So, if you're casting about for a tax break on education savings, your choices are quite limited. Some financial sacrifice is invariably involved.
