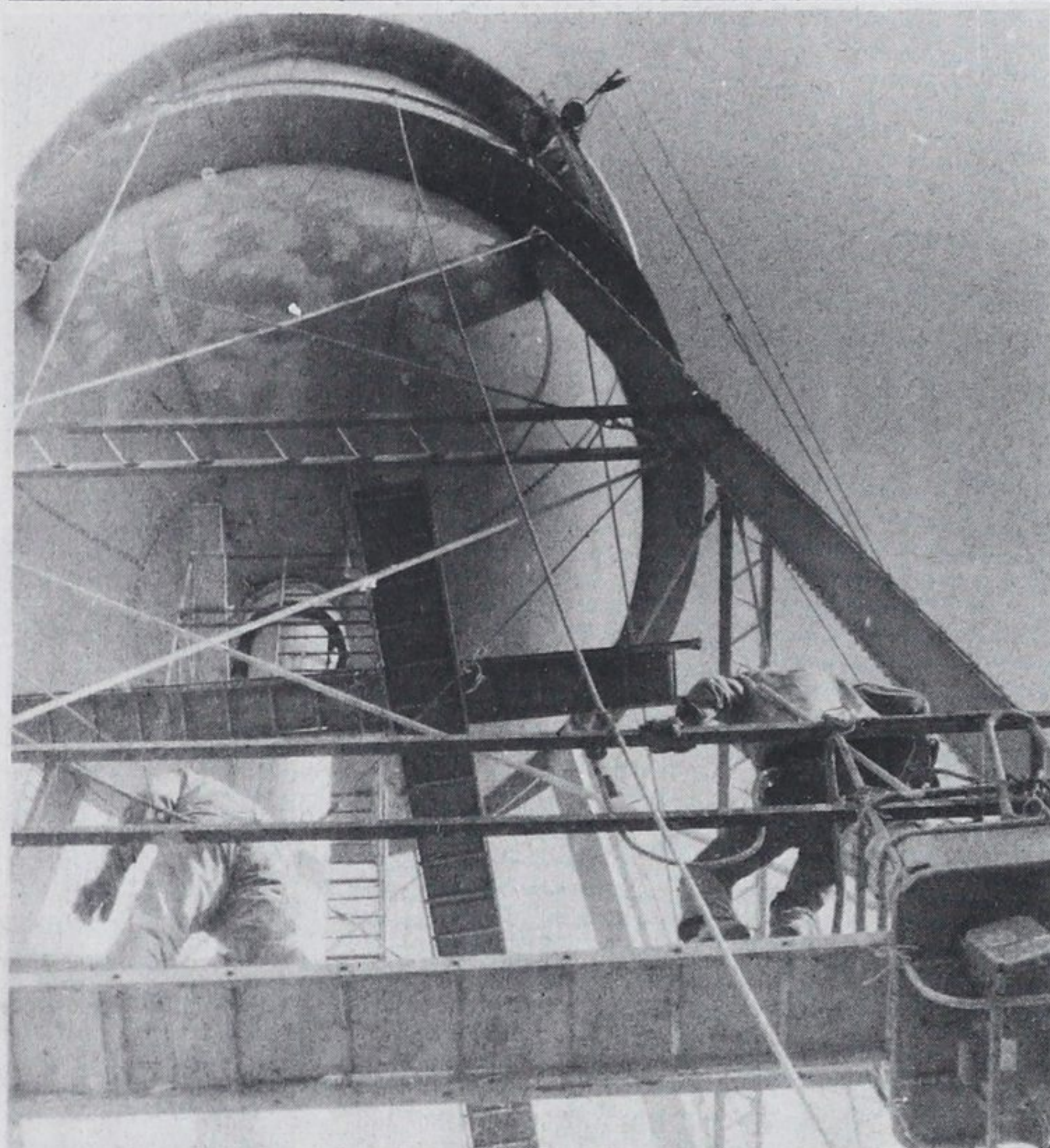




Sampling the goods

Children's crafts at This N That

From the time she was a child, making crafts for herself, Brenda Hoskin dreamed of having her own craft store. This past year she realized that dream, converting half of her successful bakery into a craft shop, calling it This 'N That.

Now Hoskin wants to share her talents with children and with other adults. She is offering a wide variety of adult courses: crochet, smocking, soft sculpture, candle wicking, rug hooking, wreaths, eggery, plastic canvas, Christmas crafts and more. Some courses are given in the afternoons and some in the evening.

Every Saturday afternoon, with the help of Sharon Johnston, Hoskin runs a craft class for children between age eight and 14. The class goes from 1 p.m. to 4 p.m. in the back of the store. The fee is \$5 per week, and includes supplies.

Last Saturday eight students turned up to make a Fridgie, a J-

cloth doll which attaches magnetically to the refrigerator. Next week the craft will be soft-sculptured Halloween witches.

Hoskin chooses the craft for each session. However, she encourages the children to be as original and creative as possible, so the finished products vary from one student to the next.

Children are welcome to attend any or all Saturday classes. If the response is good, they will continue into spring.
