Despite a decrease in attendance, the Summer, Antique Market had a profitable year, giving \$4,400 to the general fund.

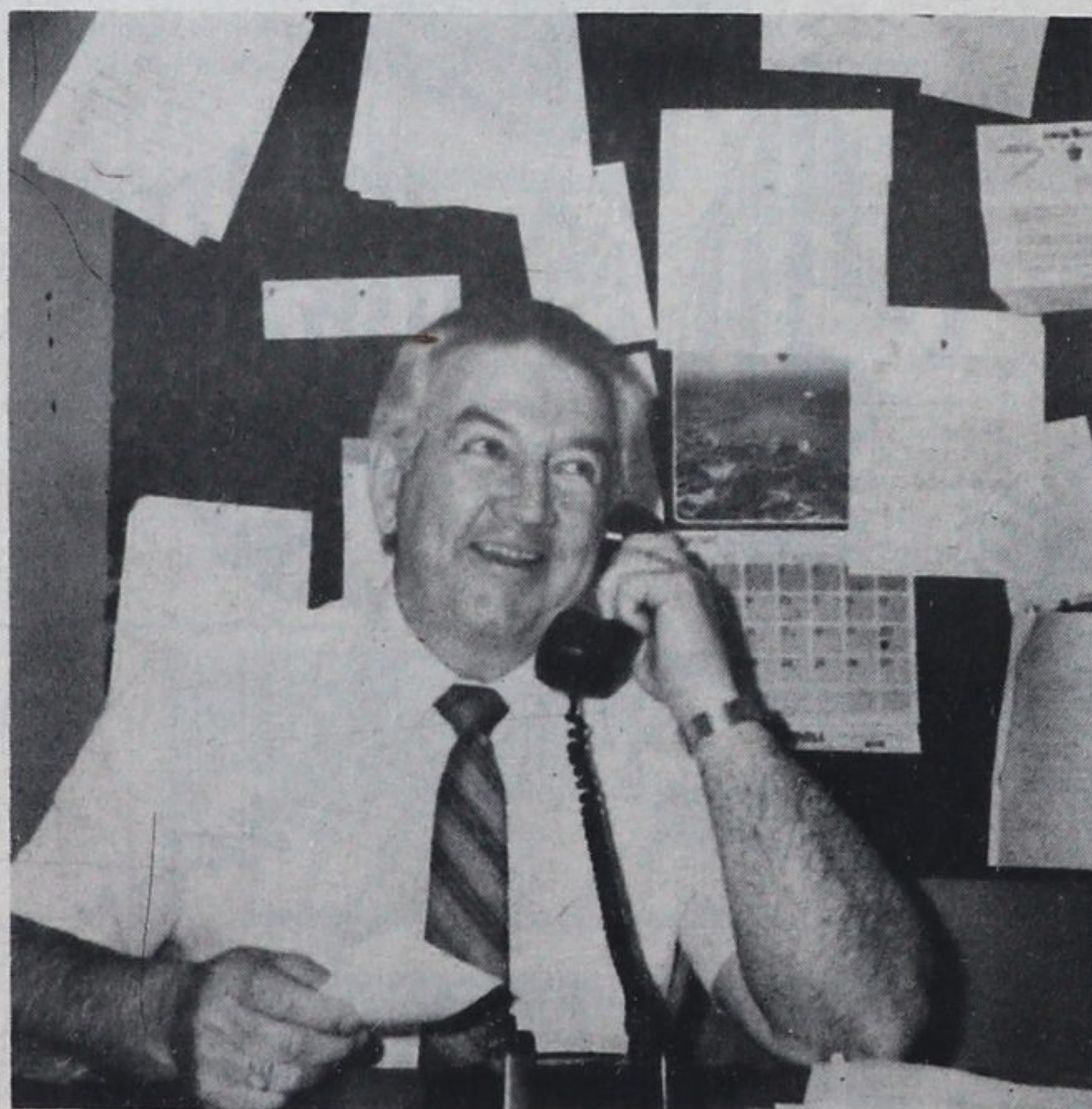
Tag Day receipts
