# EXTENDED ROMAN CATHOLIC SEPARATE SCHOOL FUNDING

VOTERS SENT A MESSAGE THROUGH THE BALLOT BOX: LET'S MAKE SURE IT WAS HEARD AT QUEEN'S PARK

On May 2nd, voters used the ballot box to send a message to all three parties at Queen's Park.

- The democratic process was bypassed when extended funding was announced almost one year ago for Roman Catholic Separate Secondary Schools.
- We must determine whether the proposed extension is legal and constitutional *before* the government proceeds with costly implementation.

... a burning issue is being treated by all three parties as a non-issue, a *fait accompli* with details to be worked out somehow in time to force the plan into operation somewhere, by September. It is the antithesis of responsible management of public affairs."
