Never miss the opportunity to pick up an old general collection. They're dirt cheap, you may find an item you've been seeking for years, and in any case, you never know what you'll learn.

A keen collector I know has many special areas of interests and collects in a number of topics. But she has an extensive general collection ("of stamps I like to look at") as yet another offshoot of the hobby. She regularly goes through at least a half-dozen old albums each month picking out a few here, a few there. It passes the time, and is inexpensive.

Before I go on, I'll anticipate your question: Where can I get this type of material?

The answer is, in daily and weekly newspaper classifieds, at flea markets, rural or suburban auctions. In your area, if you don't see any advertised, place a wanted ad yourself. You may be surprised at what the small charge for the ad will bring in return.

One of the albums the collector came across recently was entitled The Triumph Stamp Album for Postage Stamps of the World. There's no date to indicate when it was published, although it has only 340 pages, plus a dozen or so pages of advertising. That's not much for a world collection.

One clue of age is that the Flyleaf is rubberstamped A.H. Vincent, Stamp Dealer, with a Montreal address. The dean of U.S. philatelic dealers and

writers, Herman "Pat" Hearst Jr. says he dealt with Vincent in the early 1930s, when he visited Montreal regularly to buy U.S. material in the Canadian depressed market.

Another clue is that none of the illustrations of British Commonwealth stamps show a monarch after King George V, who reigned from 1910 to 1936.

A page introducing the album is entitled "King of Hobbies, Hobby of Kings" and lists members of various royal families from around the world -- there were more then than now -- who were stamp collectors.

Foremost, of course, was King George V, who is quoted as writing that stamp collecting "is one of the greatest

pleasures of my life." Many years later, another very important person was to write and say much the same, that his stamp collecting got him through the dark days of the Second World War. That was Franklin Delano Roosevelt, president of the United States.
