Decision rests with arbitrator

An arbitrator has as many as 90 days to deliver his decision, after last Friday hearing argument from the Town of Midland and the Midland Police Association.

The town and the association could not agree on a change in pension eligibility proposed by the association for its next contract.

The association represents 16 uniformed members. The two parties also could not agree on a 30 years and out retirement provision for town police officers. Two serving Midland police force members were town employees before the pension plan for town police officers was started in 1963. The association wants credit for their full service given to those two officers.

Constable Danny Gilbert, an association spokesman, yesterday said he believes that agreement could have been reached if not for

the pension disagreement.

Gilbert estimated that the proposed change in pension provisions would mean an extra \$5,657 in the first year in the police department budget, or the equivalent of a 1.6 percent wage increase. The town offered a five percent wage increase but no change in the pension provisions, he said.

On average decisions are delivered in 30 days, Gilbert said.

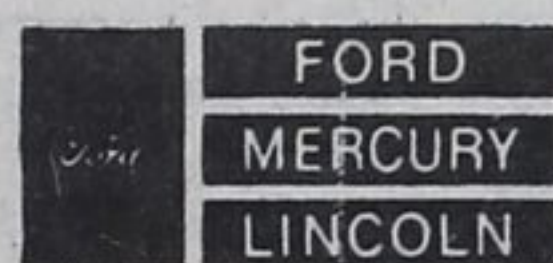
