Dolly's baskets are made with the coil method, which

gives strength and versatility. She may be one of the few people you'll ever meet who has made a table with this basket technique "I made the table-top, covered it with a piece of glass and put it on a wrought iron base that John Robitaille made for me."

Dolly Heasman was born in Elmville and, except for a few years teaching in Scarborough, she has lived all her life in Huronia. "The money was good in Toronto," she says bluntly, "but the air made me sick. I

had to move up here again to stay healthy."

She taught in the elementary school system for 12 years, then moved to MSS where she taught special

education for 18 years. She retired in 1980. "And I haven't looked back for a second."

Her interest in amateur theatricals led her to

become the official promoter for dozens of Huronia Players productions. She has been a Friend of Sainte-Marie ever since the organization began. "When

you live in a community, you must give something back," she says firmly.

Dolly Heasman's baskets and her basket making course are popular com-
