Lalonde says the water is so pure because of large sand deposits the water flows through on its way into Pentang Bay. As a result the water is tested each Monday for chloroform and bacteria always comes back negative.

The commissioner says the well is a cheap source of clean water because it does not cost the town money to pump it to the surface.

Natural pressure forces the water to rise 200 feet from bedrock to ground level. The pressure is caused by the water's movement from higher to lower ground as it travels from the surrounding hills to the bay. Lalonde says the pressure is strong enough to push the water 15 feet into the air if the well were left uncapped.

Lalonde says many cottagers prefer the water out of the Penetang well over their own shallow wells because they know they are getting the best in water quality.

Four years ago the town undertook an extensive renovation of the well:

The old gravel parking lot which was often full of muddy pot holes was paved and a new reservoir and filling station was installed.
