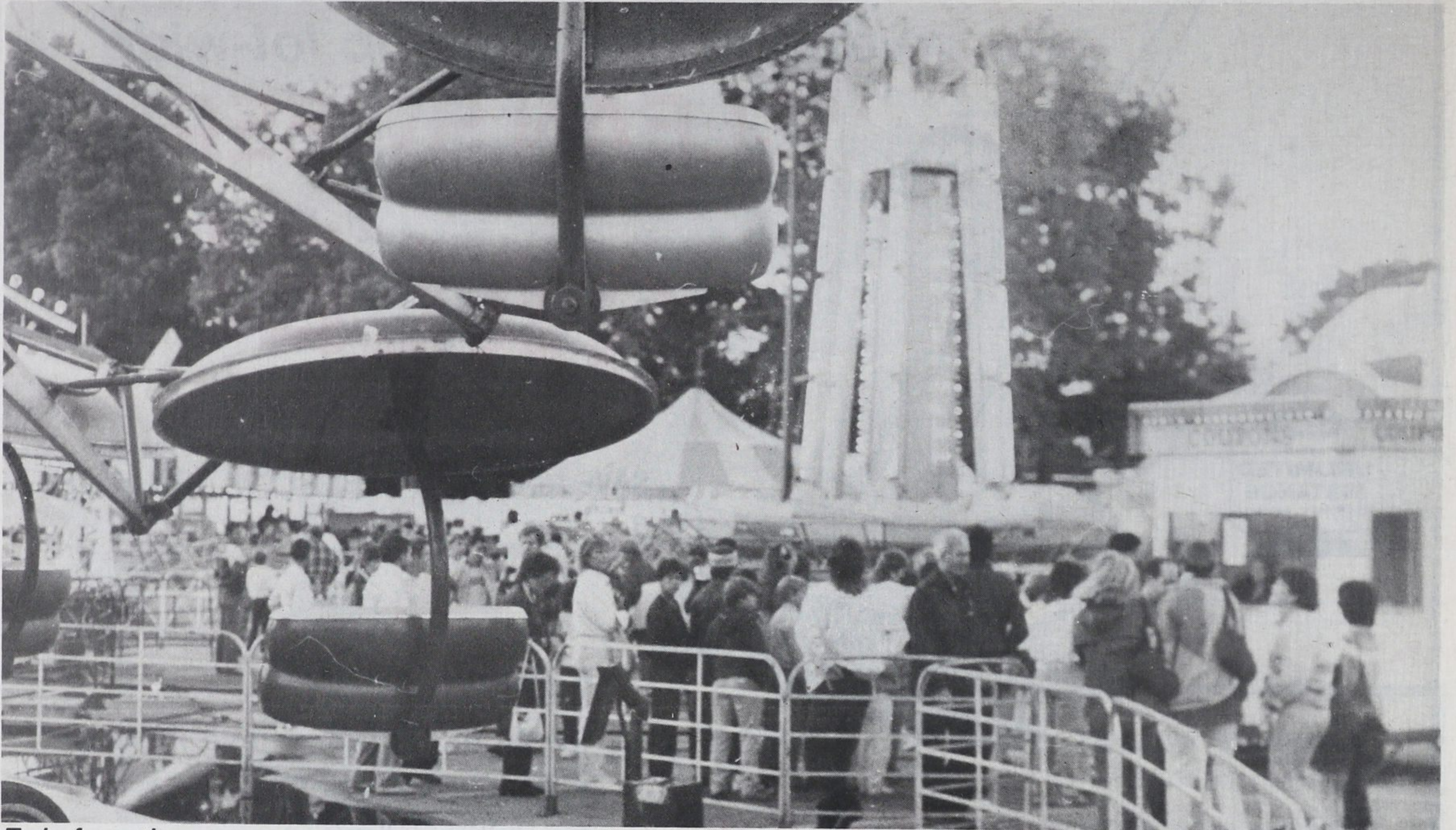


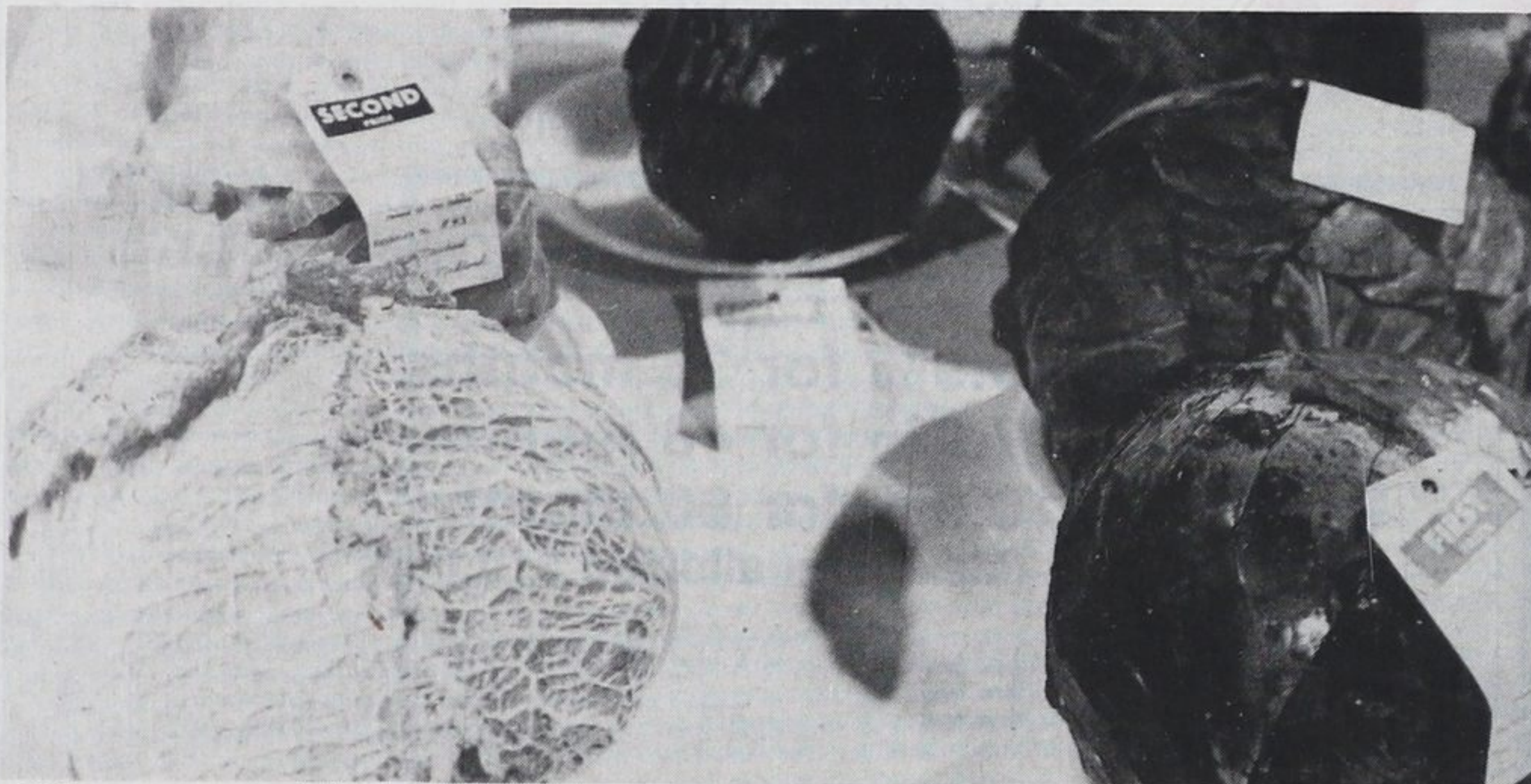
Midland's fall fair full of fun ...
