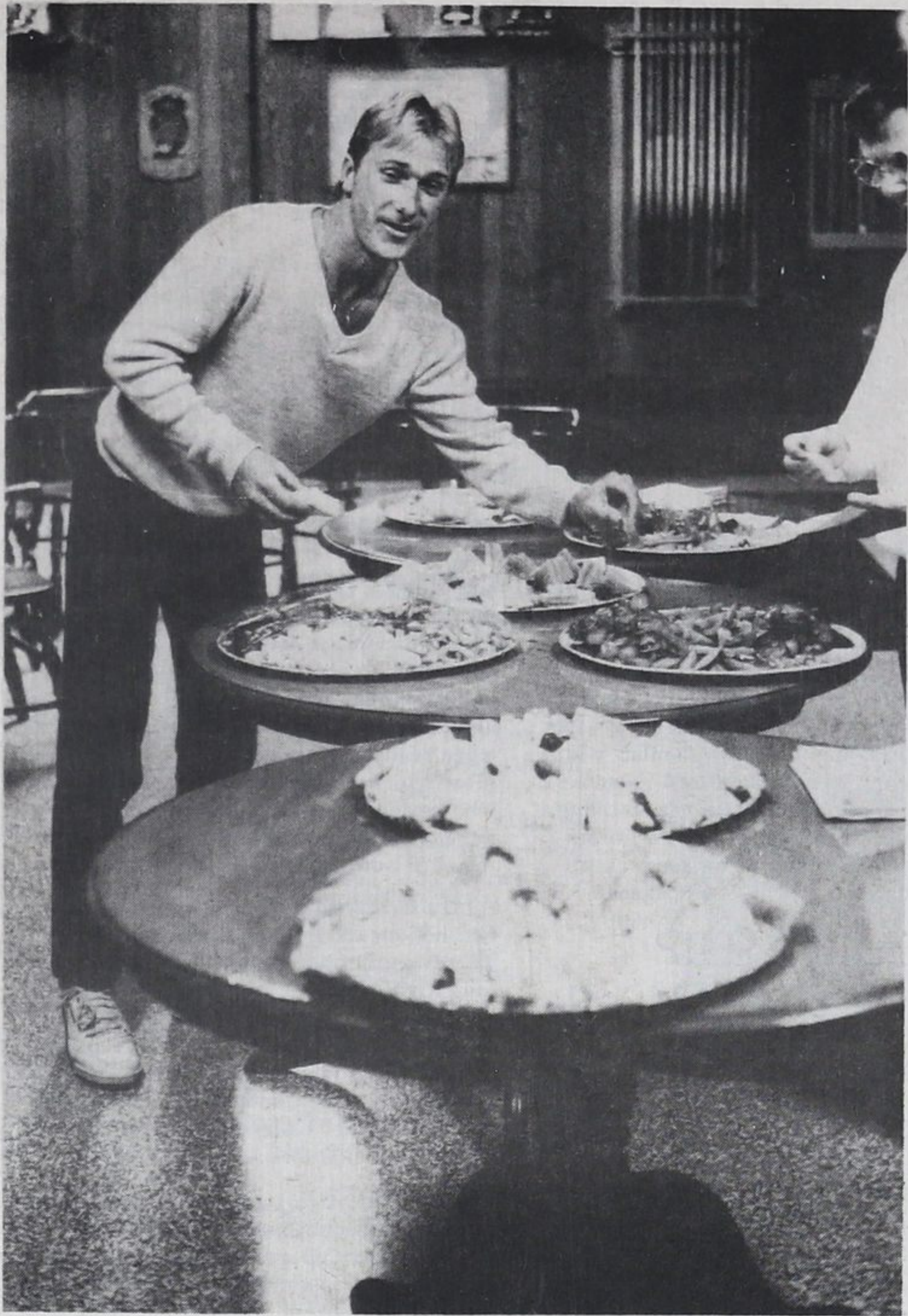


# Legion week...A tradition of pride

Cub and Girl Guide packs. A track and field program at all levels of the Command leading to the Provincial and Dominion Championships 40 athletes chosen to represent Ontario in the National Championship. 100 Branches are actively engaged in the pursuit of this program.

Veterans Hospitals.
