One hundred and thirty-two vehicles were checked. The result was the issuance of two 12-hour suspensions, one liquor offence charge, and five other traffic charges.

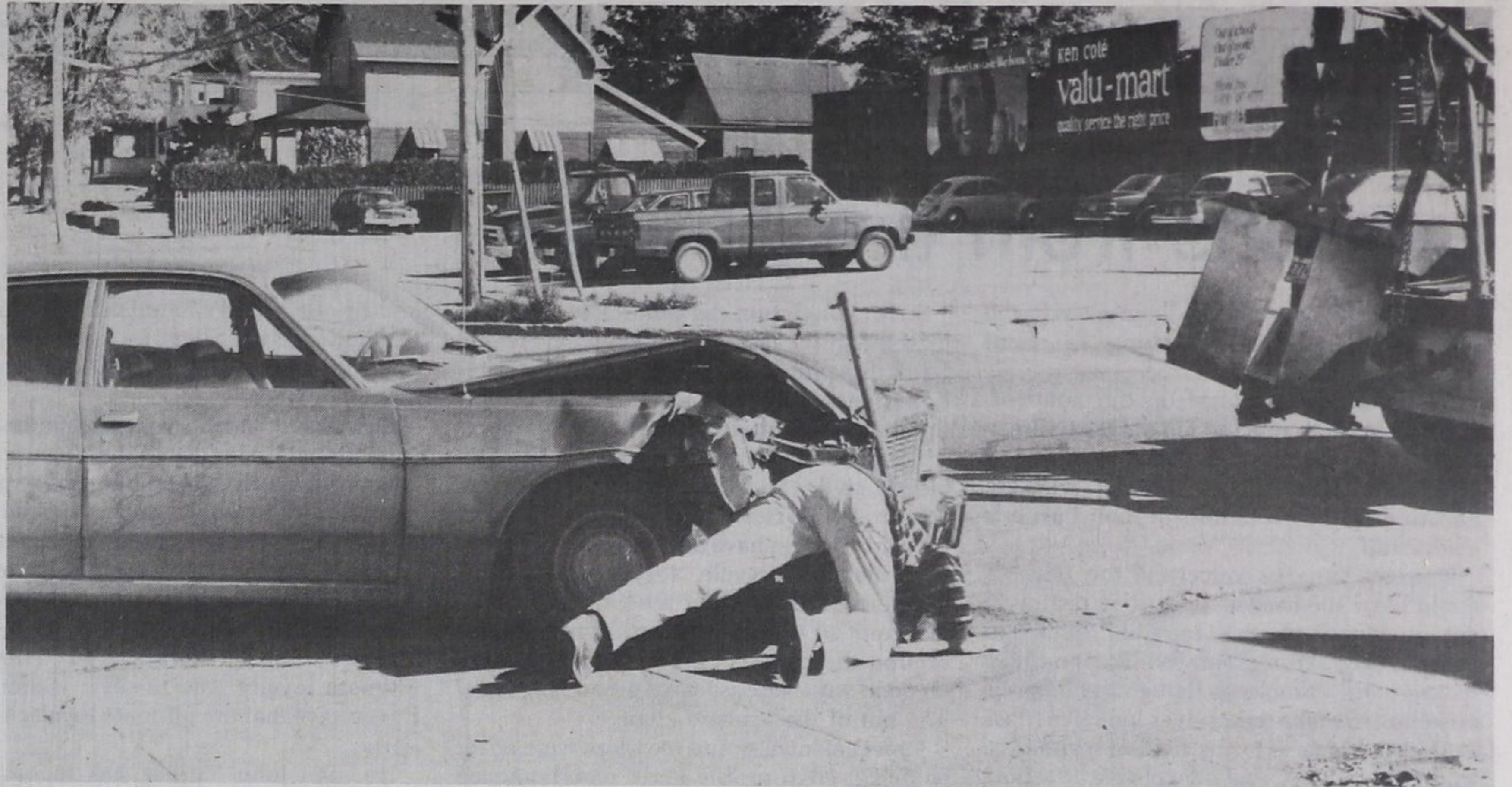
Fun at Wye Marsh

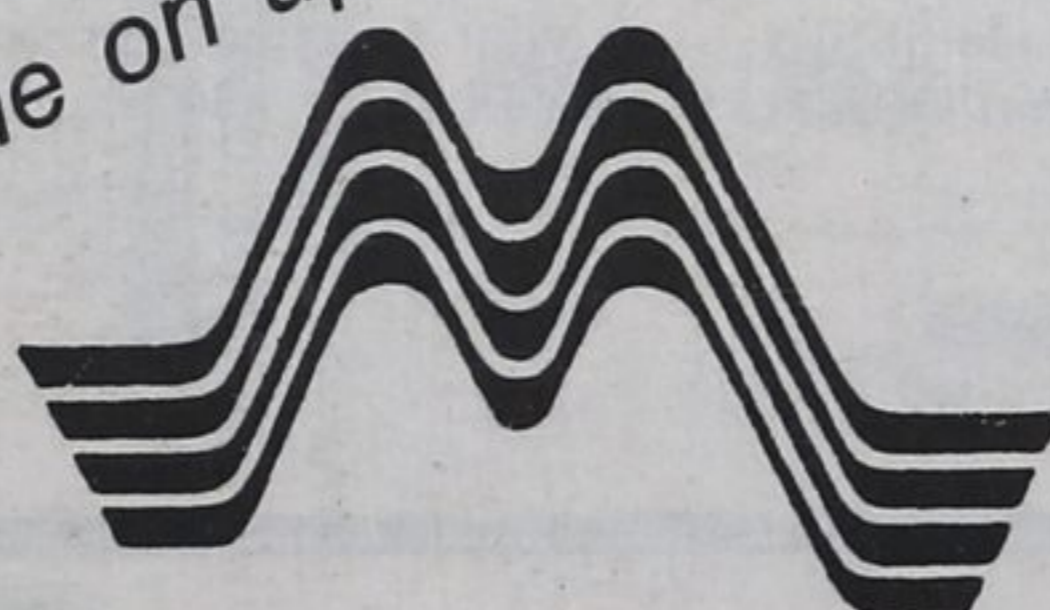
