more children into the program, and if anyone has any questions they can contact Mary Garthside at 549-2861 or Cathy Moore at 526-6973.

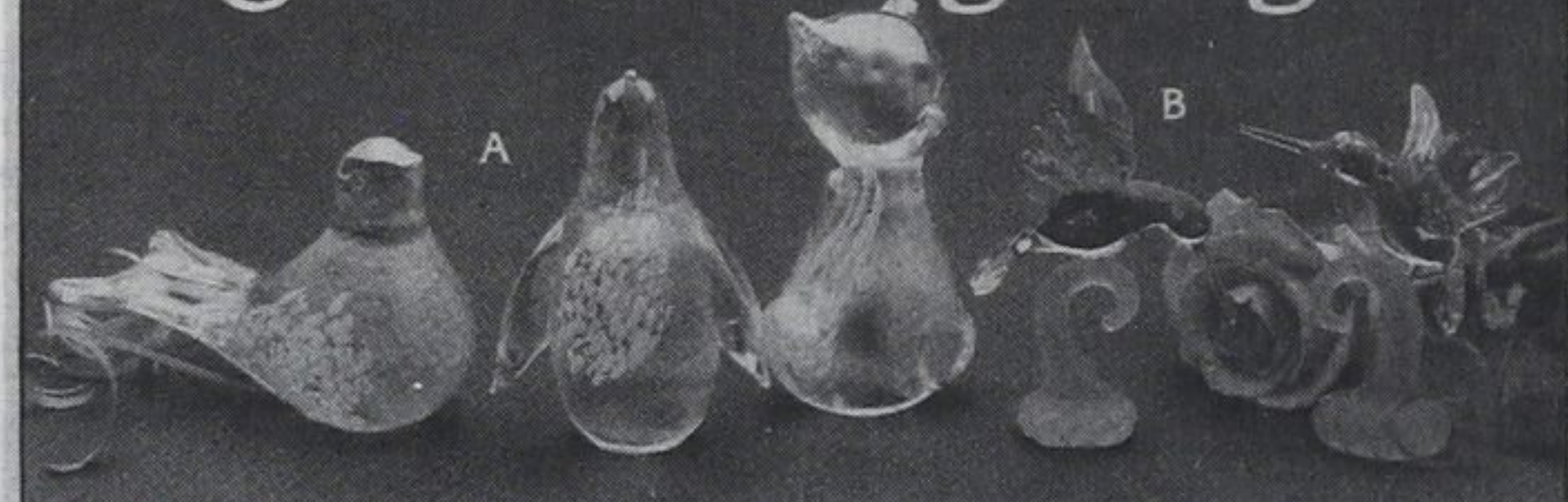

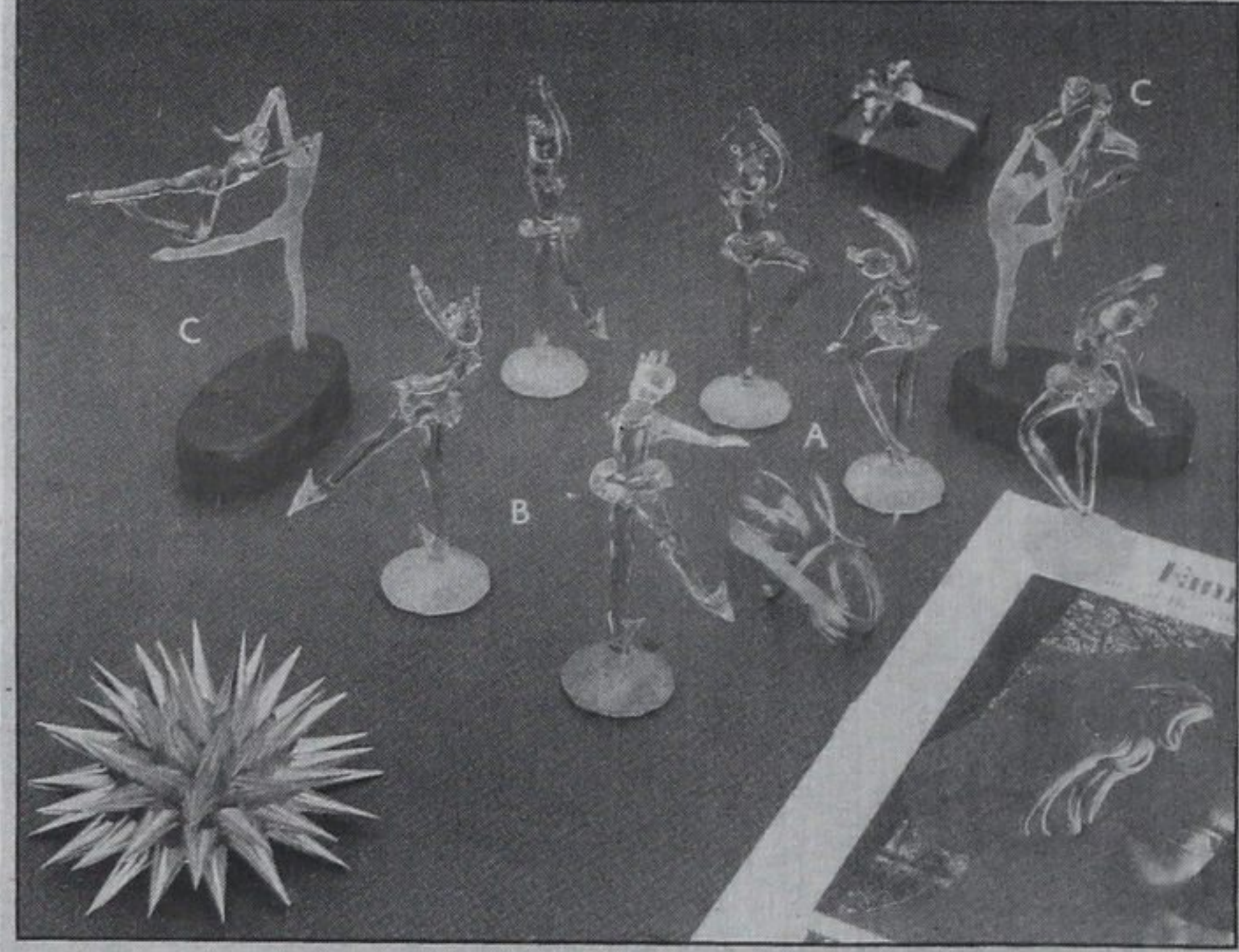

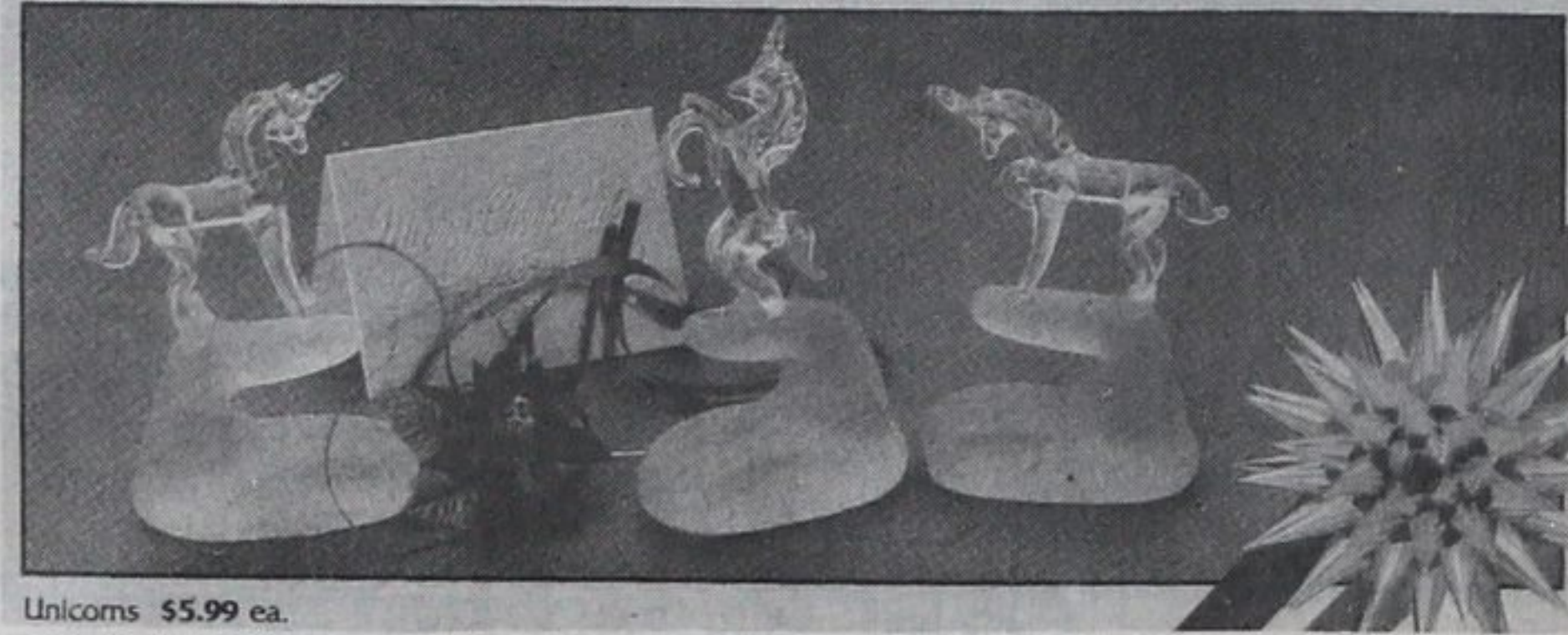
