Notice of Application for Approval to Expropriate

IN THE MATTER OF an application by THE CORPORATION OF TINY for approval to expropriate land being Lots 4 Street, Registered Plan 327, (Hamlet of Wyevale), in the Township of Simcoe for the purpose of an addition to and obtaining an entrance to a Public Park. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that application has been made for approval to expropriate the land described as follows:

Lots 4 and 5, north side of Queen Street, Registered Plan 327, (Hamlet of Wyevale), in the Township of Tiny, in the County of Simcoe.

Any owner of lands in respect of which notice is given who desires an inquiry into whether the taking of such land is fair, sound and reasonably necessary in the achievement of the objectives of the expropriating authority shall so notify the approving authority in writing.

- in the case of a registered owner, served personally or by registered mail within thirty days after he is served with the notice, or, when he is served by publication, within thirty days after the first publication of the notice;
- in the case of an owner who is not a registered owner, within thirty days after the first publication of the notice.

- The Expropriations Act provides that,
 - where an inquiry is requested, it shall be conducted by an inquiry officer appointed by the Attorney General;
 - the inquiry officer,
 - shall give every party to the inquiry evidence and argument and to examine witnesses, either personally or by
 - may recommend to the approving authority that a fixed amount for the inquiry be paid a fixed amount for to exceed \$200.00 and the approving authority may in its discretion order the expropriating authority to pay such costs forthwith.
- "owner" and "registered owner" are defined in the act as follows:

"owner" includes a mortgagee, tenant, execution creditor, a person entitled to a limited estate or interest in land, a committee of the estate of a mentally incompetent person or of a person incapable of managing his affairs, and a guardian, executor, administrator or trustee in whom land is vested;

"registered owner" means an owner of land whose interest in the land is defined and whose name is specified in an instrument in the proper land registry or sheriff's office, and includes a person shown as a tenant of land on the last revised assessment roll.
- The expropriating authority, each owner who notifies the approving authority that he desires a hearing in respect of the lands intended to be expropriated and any owner added as a party by the inquiry officer are parties to the inquiry.

RENSEIGNEMENTS SUR L'ACCÈS AUX ÉCOLES

La loi provinciale reconnaît l'existence de deux systèmes scolaires distincts en Ontario, soit le système des écoles publiques et le système des écoles séparées.

La loi reconnaît également à tout élève éligible à fréquenter une école secondaire, sans regard à la langue ni au système scolaire supporté, le droit de fréquenter une école secondaire relevant du système public ou séparé, sans versement de frais.

Les élèves résidents qui fréquentent présentement une école élémentaire ou secondaire séparée et dont les parents ou gardiens supportent le système séparé peuvent graduer ou transférer à une école secondaire publique sans versement de frais et sans effectuer le transfert d'impôts fonciers.

Les élèves résidents qui fréquentent présentement une école élémentaire séparée et dont les parents ou gardiens supportent le système scolaire séparé peuvent fréquenter une école élémentaire publique pourvu que les impôts fonciers sont transférés au système public.

Les élèves résidents dont les parents ou gardiens supportent le système scolaire public ne peuvent pas effectuer un transfert à une école élémentaire séparée, avec ou sans versement de frais.

Il demeure la politique du Conseil de l'éducation de Simcoe et de son Conseil de l'enseignement en langue française que l'accès aux renseignements concernant l'inscription, le programme et/ou le choix des cours des écoles secondaires publiques ou séparées est garanti pour tous. Vous pouvez vous procurer ces renseignements à l'école élémentaire de votre enfant ou aux écoles secondaires.

SCHOOL ACCESS INFORMATION

Provincial law recognizes the existence of two distinct school systems in Ontario, namely the public school boards and the separate school boards.

Provincial legislation also guarantees to any student eligible to attend a secondary school, regardless of language or tax support, the right to attend a secondary school in either the public or separate system without the payment of fees.

Resident students whose parents or guardians are separate school supporters, currently attending a separate elementary or secondary school, may graduate or transfer to a public secondary school without the payment of fees and without changing tax support.

Resident students, whose parents or guardians are separate school supporters, currently attending a separate elementary school may transfer to a public elementary school upon changing tax support to public schools.

Resident students, whose parents or guardians are public school supporters, may not transfer to a separate elementary school with or without payment of fees.

It is the policy of The Simcoe County Board of Education and its French-language Education Council that access to information concerning registration, programs and/or course options for secondary schools, public or separate, is guaranteed for all. This information may be obtained at your child's elementary school or at the secondary schools.
