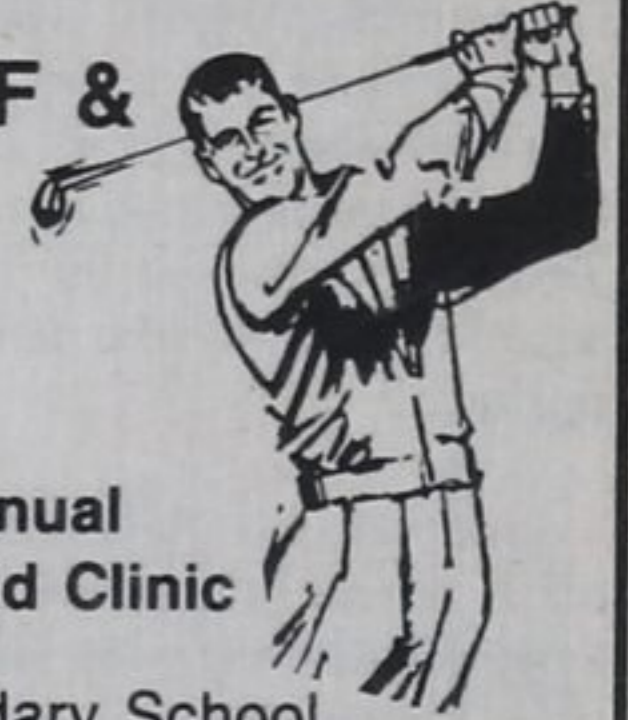

The Georgian Triangle - CFOS Spring Trout Derby will open along with the fishing season, on Saturday, April 25th at 12:01 a.m.

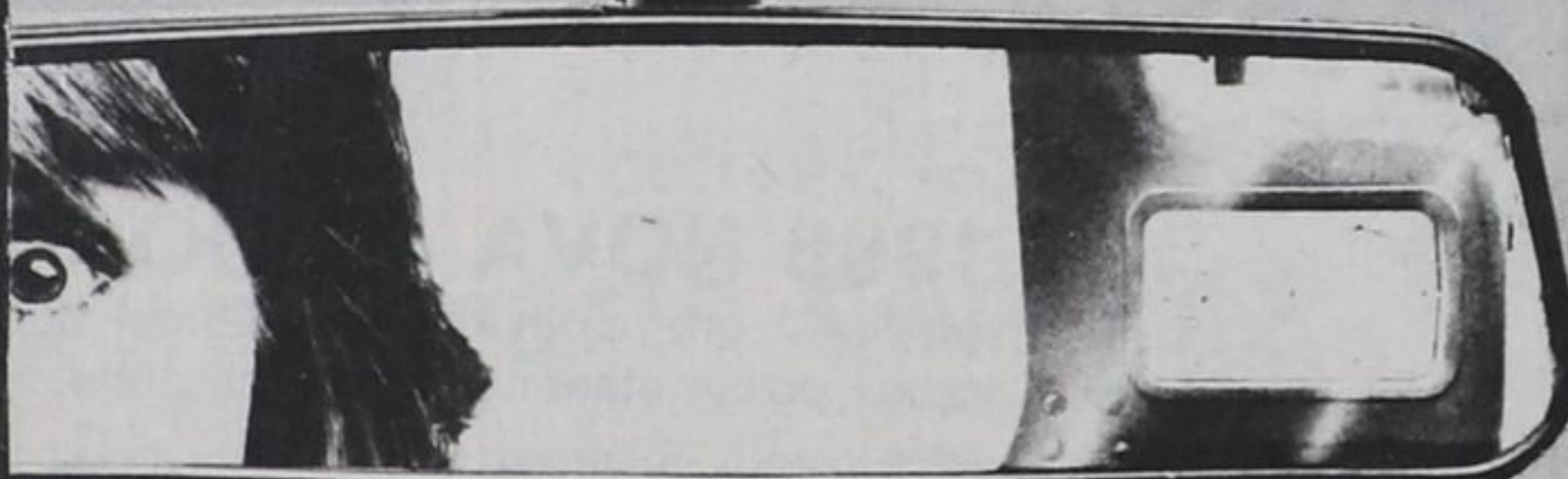
Derby officials report that rainbow and splake stocks appear high and predict an excellent spawning run.
