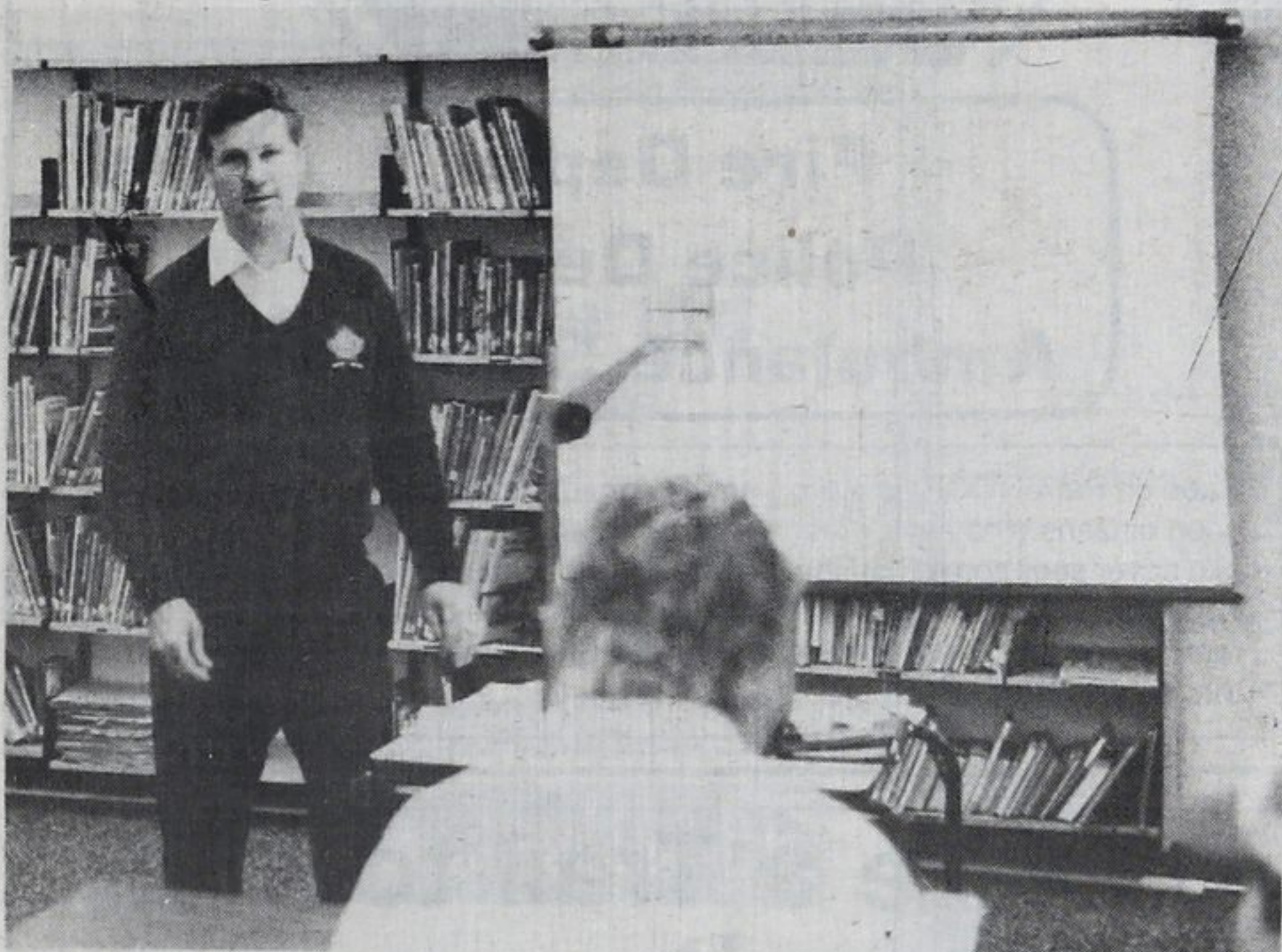

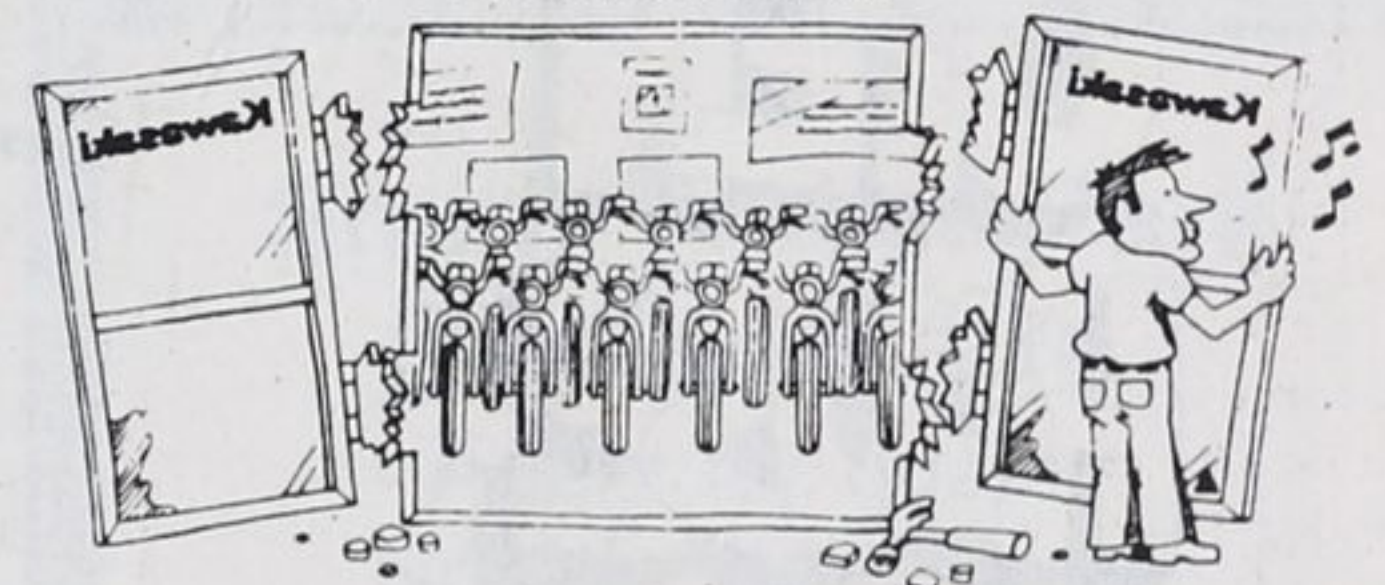
Back to School

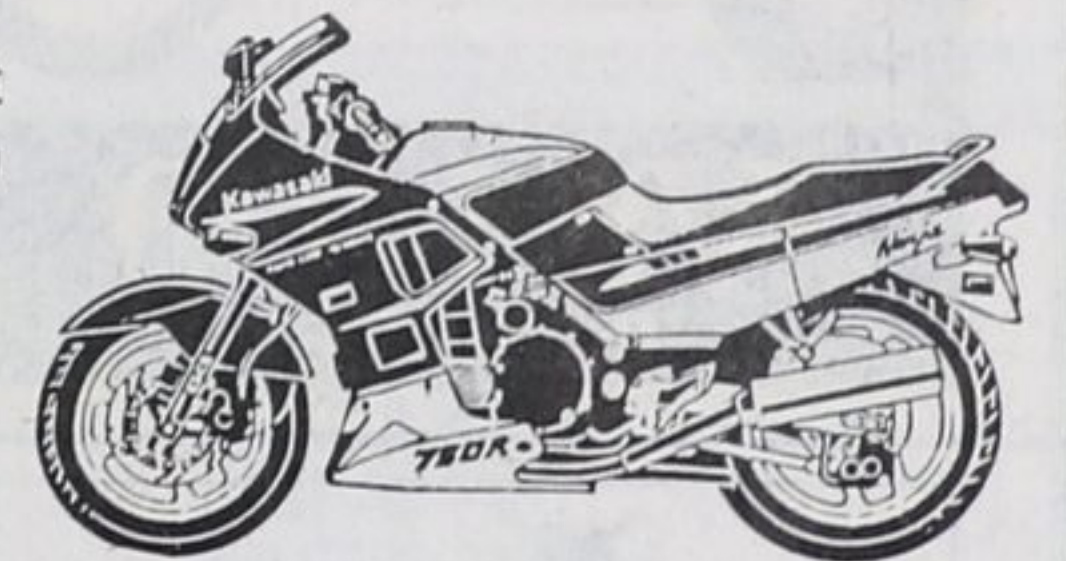

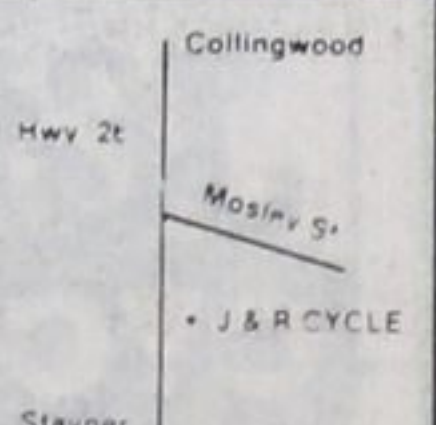
