

Cameron feels good about run

Cameron enjoyed the race more this year for a couple of reasons, the temperature was cooler and he was more familiar

with the course this time around.

Cameron was pleased with the increase in support this year, citing the fact that many people lin-

ed the route to observe the runners.

Starting the race, Cameron was aiming at 1:18, chopping four minutes off his last year's

pace, finishing at 1:16:16. Cameron noted that he had

run a half marathon in Scotland in 67 minutes, but added that the course was a lot flatter than this one.

He suggested that an hour and 15 minutes might be possible for someone in the future. He did not rule out the possibility of hitting that barrier himself, although he stopped short of admitting he would try for it next year.

Cameron sat back in the pack for the first three miles of the race, running with eventual second place finisher Mark Taylor, but pulled away after the three mile mark.

'I felt good, I was running within myself', stated Cameron who felt good enough at the finish line to state he could do another six miles. After last year's race, Cameron termed the course 'gruelling'.



At The Finish

This runner didn't win the race, but he still crossed the finish line at any rate. All but one of the participants in Sunday's MMPTT Half Marathon crossed the line in excellent times. Several runners chopped six or seven minutes off last year's times. Evan

Cameron broke his own course record set last year. The run, which is sponsored annually in large part by Meatland and also Borsa Produce, was divided into three categories; class, masters and ladies.
