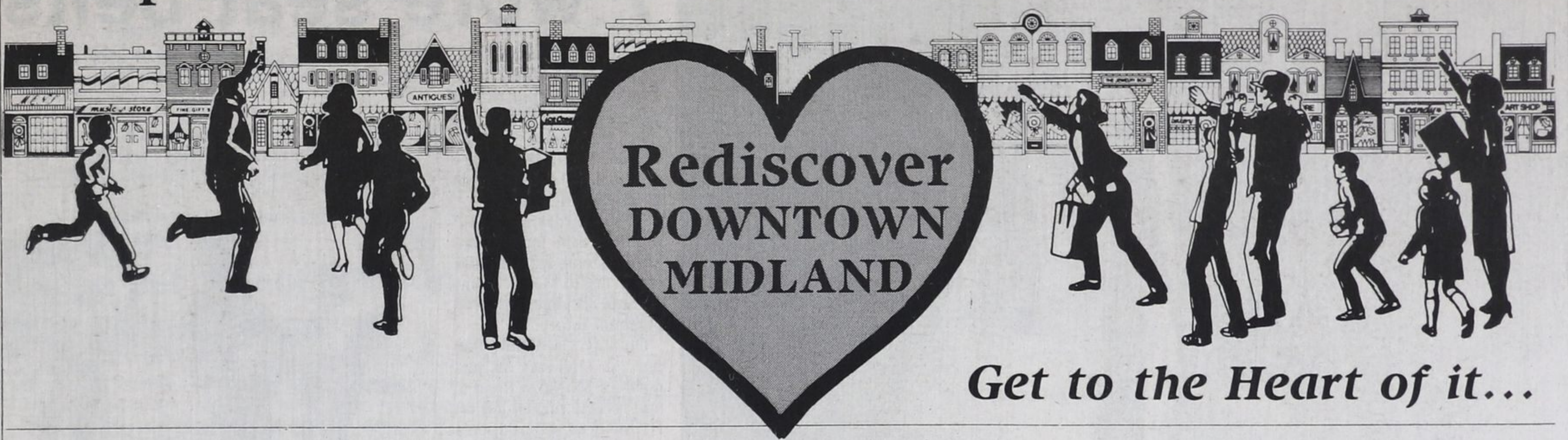

Both Wolfgang and Marlene say, "We have always tried to practice good quality products that are attractive to the eye and pleasing to the palate. Service and customer satisfaction is important to us."

The Georgian Home Bakery carries a variety of

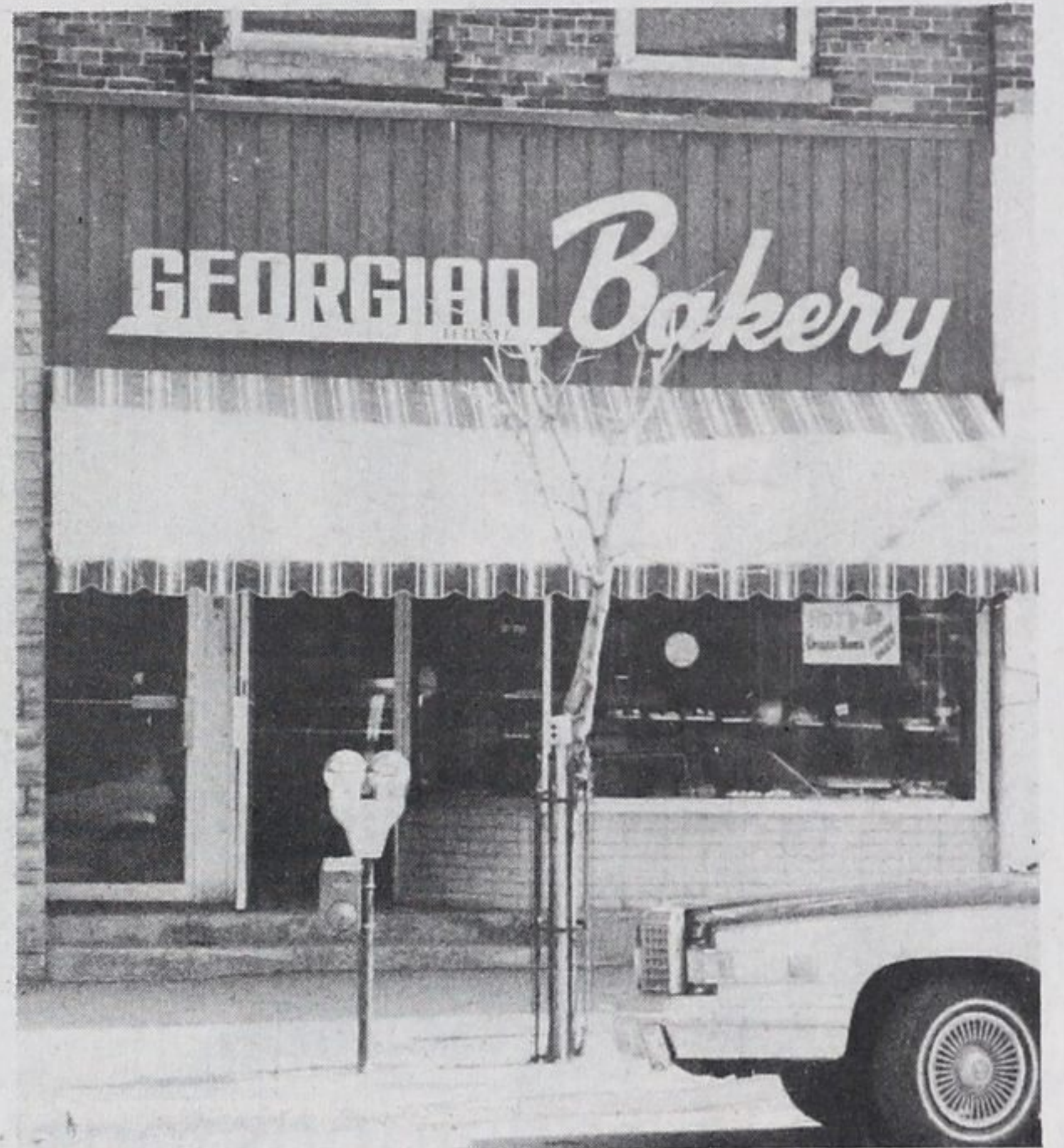
bread, rolls, donuts, danish pastries, assorted meat pies, cream items, birthday and wedding cakes and much more.
