St. Theresa High School will be sending 14 athletes to the Georgian Bay Track and Field Meet tomorrow in Oshawa to compete in 26 events.

The athletes qualified at the Zone II Meet Thursday in Orillia.

In the midget girls division, Heather McGregor will represent St. T's in the 800 and 1500 meter. Robin Merkley will compete in the 100m and Tanya Anderson qualified in both the 100m and javelin.

Chrissy Blackwell advances in the 1500m event, while Sandra Chapman qualified in the 3000m, 80m hurdles and the 400m hurdles.

David Forrest will compete in the long jump, high jump and 400m for the midget boys. Andy Bowers advances in the pole vault, high jump and triple jump. Trevor Irvine and Terry Lorette will also compete in the midget boys pole vault event with Lorette also tacking the high jump. Sean Hook will be in the javelin competition while Steve Roth is in both the 110m and 400m hurdles.

Dave Cadieux advances in the triple and high jumps, while Alex Therrien will attempt to improve on his second place zone II finish. Gig Leader will round out the senior boys compliment by taking a run at the 100m.

St. T's Notes: Paul Cox, a former St. T's student is currently attempting to earn a spot on the National Men's Volleyball squad to participate in the 1988 Calgary Winter Olympics.

The Ontario Universities Athletic Association All Star and captain of the Ontario Champion University of Toronto, is likely one of the best verticals in camp.

Cox graduated from St. T's in 1982 before atten-
