## Who is eligible to Vote?

Those persons who on Election Day -

- Are 18 years of age.
- Are Canadian Citizens.
- Have resided in Ontario for the preceding 6 months.

Are eligible to vote if their name is on the NEW LIST of VOTERS for the Electoral District in which they reside, or on a CERTIFICATE to VOTE as issued by their Returning Officer.
