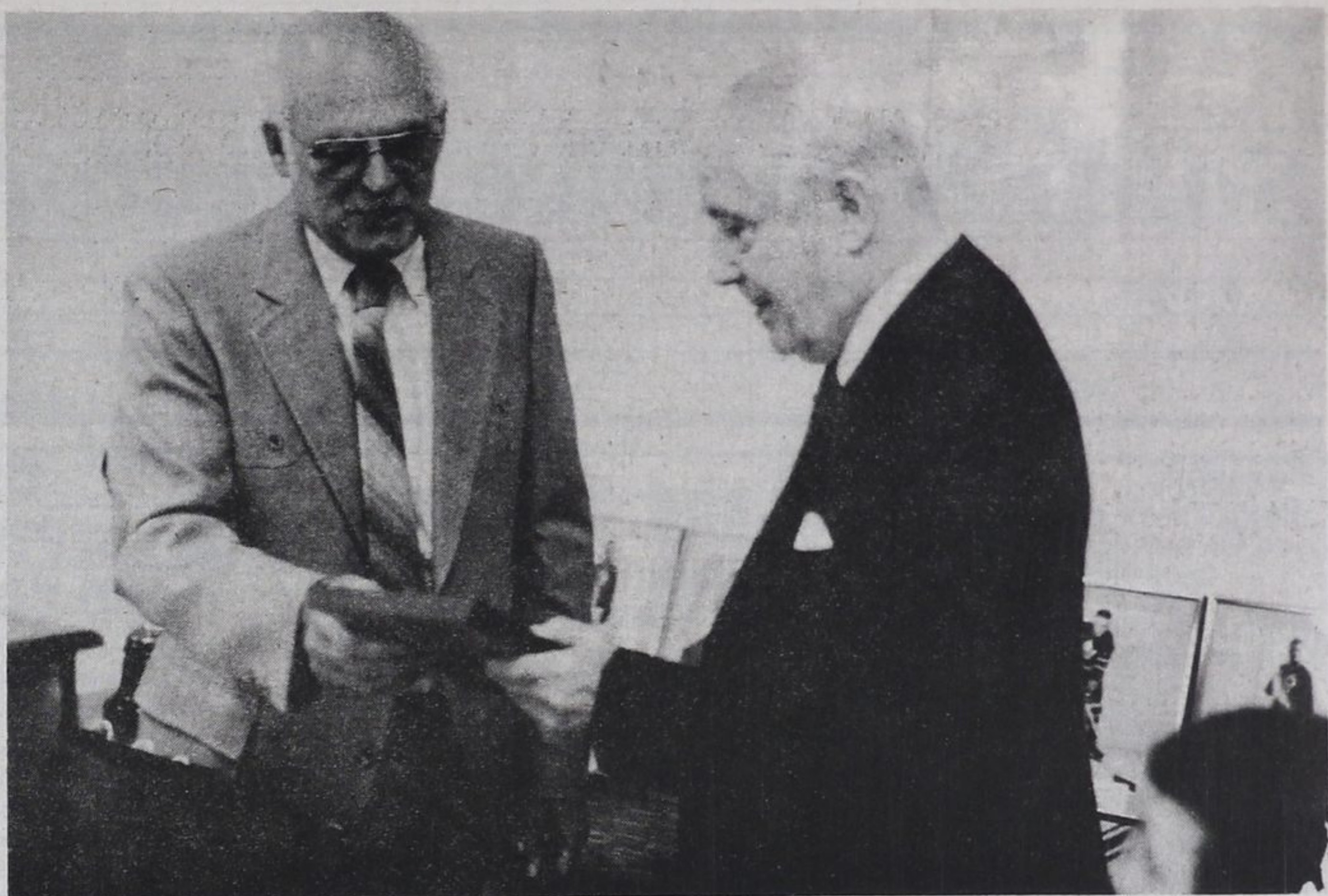




### Daughter says thanks
