Both the Bennies are still working hard at redecorating this truly marvelous home. In the future they hope to complete the third floor into a magnificent master bedroom, complete with sitting room.


The outside improvements they have made have added to the charm of their home. A recent addition of an inground swimming pool required the construction of a privacy fence. This they added without taking away from the character of the house.

The unilock driveway they laid themselves has created an old fashioned look that blends in with the overall look of the home.


Many long hours of decorating and changes has resulted in a restored older home. The Bennies can be proud of and which definitely shows their pride of ownership and respect for heritage.
