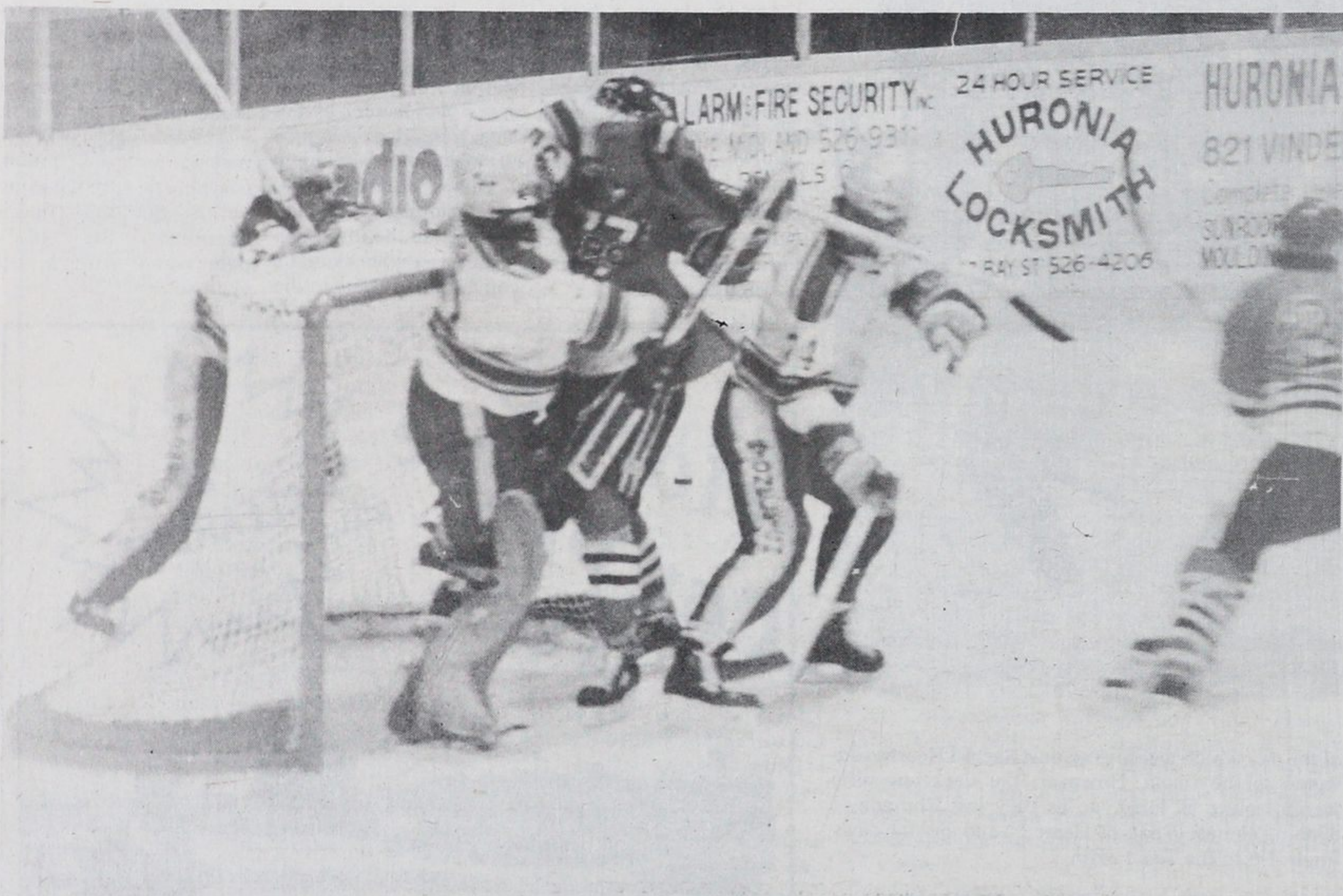


### He scores!
