Project to employ builders

Continuing a tradition of creative and innovative management, the owners of Wye Heritage Marina are asking for public input to their plan to build a Great Lakes cruise boat.

They say they'll build whatever the customers want, no matter how offbeat.

"The idea is unique," said Lori Black, public relations person for the marina. "It's truly going to be a custom-made boat. It might even be bizarre; it depends what the customers want."

The "dream boat" will also serve as a way for the marina to employ skilled boat builders during the otherwise slack winter season.

"Due to the boating business's seasonal nature these skilled people either have lots of work or none at all," says an insert in cluded with the Dec. 1 edition of the marina's newsletter.

"In order to keep our . staff from year to year we are constantly trying to find work during the slack periods," the insert says.

The boat would likely be built next winter after ideas are collected and sorted. "We're already getting a lot of good ideas," Black said. "Boaters are imaginative - and they know what they want."

This would also be the first time Wye Heritage (owned by Gord and Bob Blake) has built a boat "from scratch," Black said, although it has done extensive reconditioning of many boats.

Black says if the concept pans out the marina will repeat it year after year. "We know the market fairly well. We knew that there was a hole in the market. So we know it'll take off," Black said.

Also new at the marina: the New Year's Eve party will feature a worldly theme this time around. The Horatio Hornblower restaurant at the marina will present dishes from various ports of call, including Nova Scotia lobster, Taiwanese shark's fin soup, Italian salad and Greek Baklava.






