Foodland Ontario's new Ontario mushrooms recipe brochure features fresh locally-grown mushrooms in an appealing array of recipes and quick ideas.

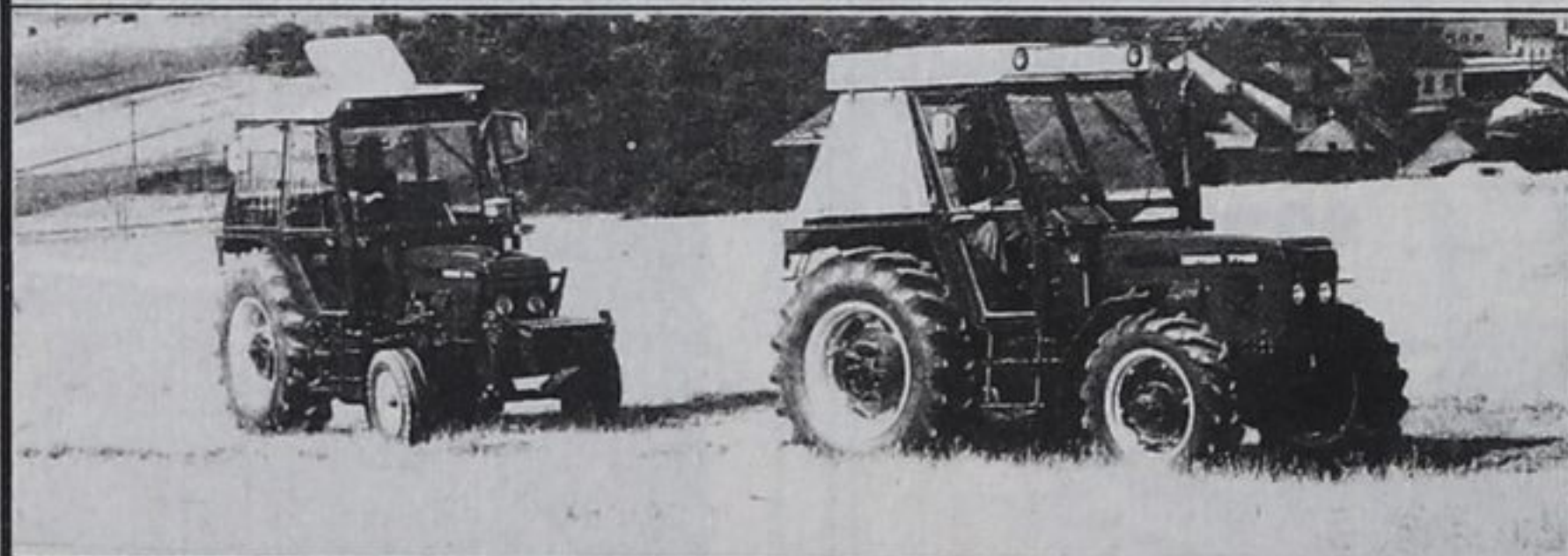
Mushrooms-in-phylo, mushroom and anise salad and double mushroom bisque are a few of the delectable recipes included.

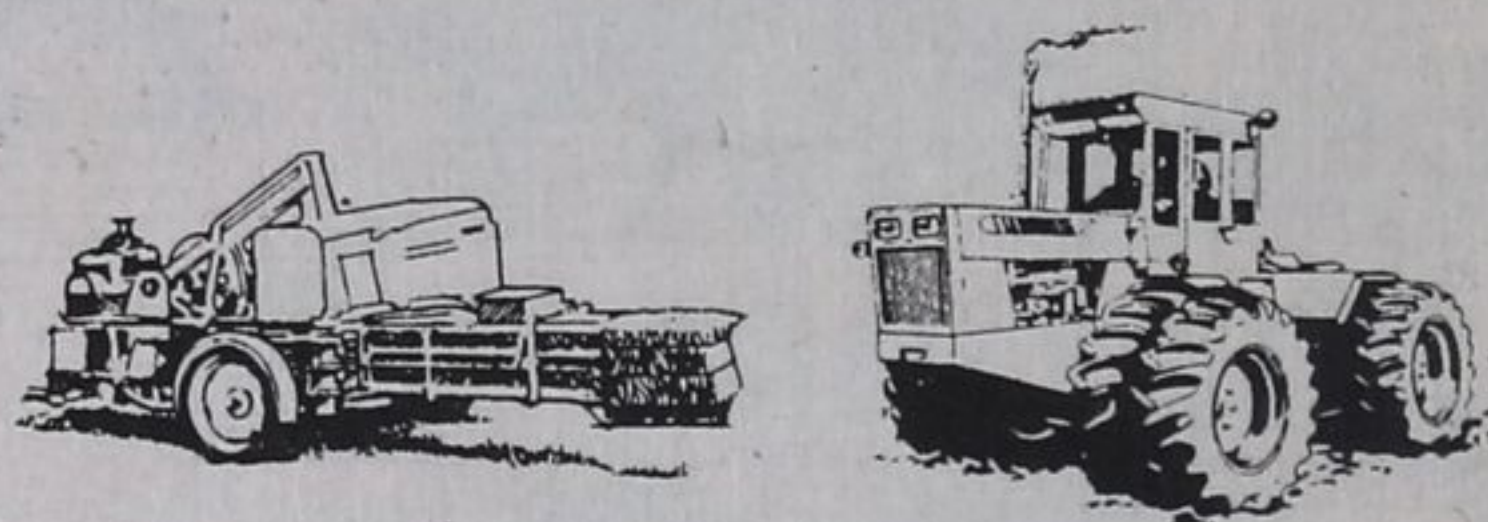

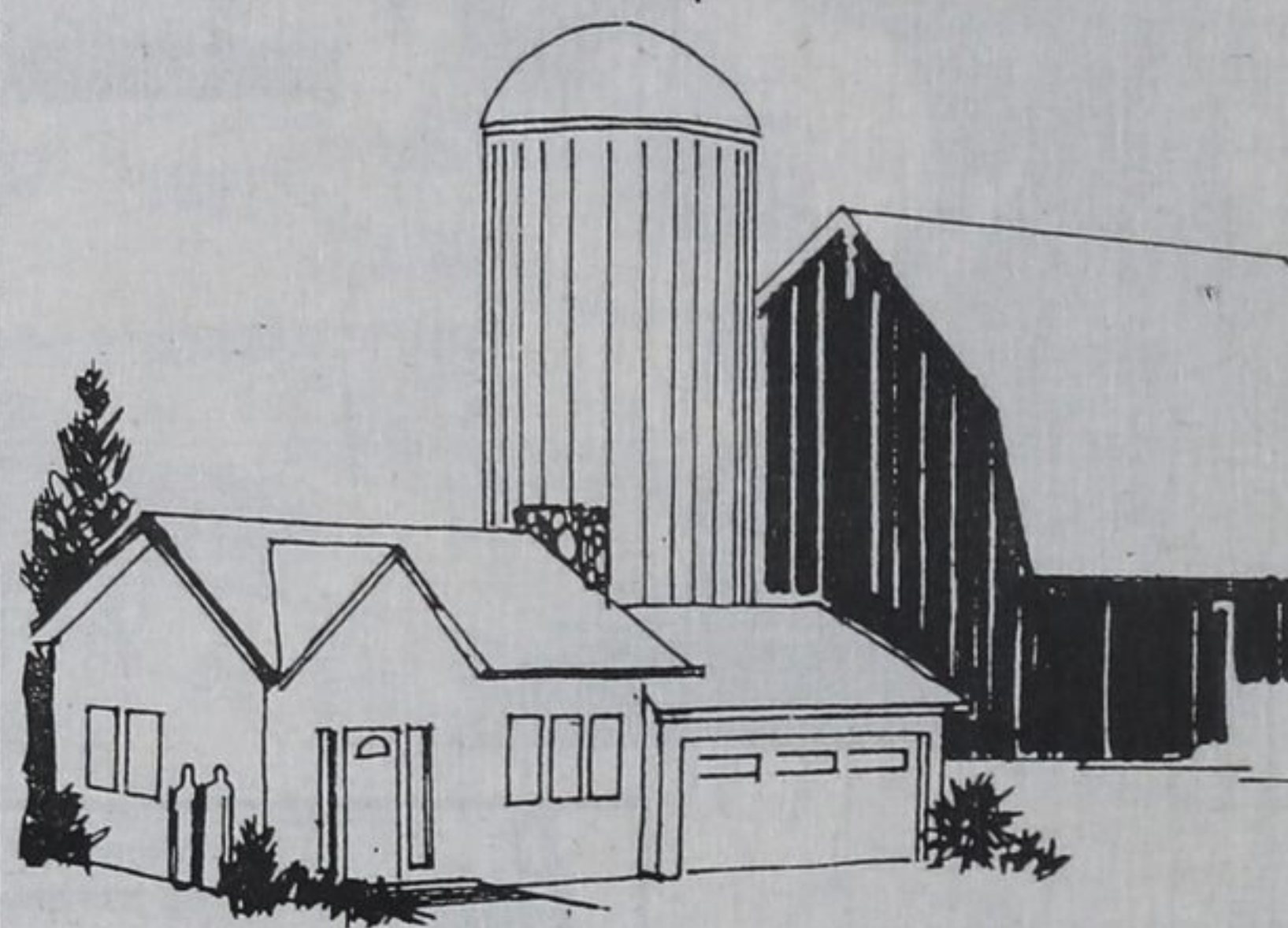

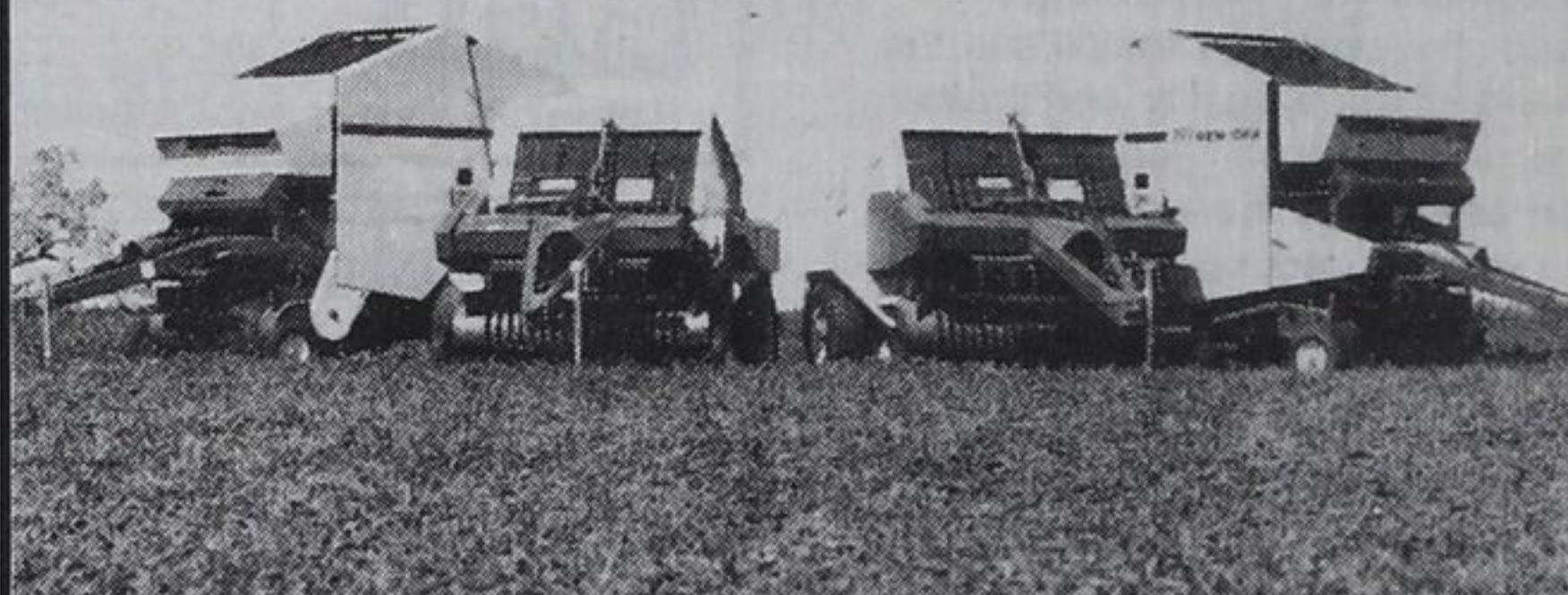
