

Midland Secondary School to have room for trainably-retarded

Midland Secondary School will be getting a new classroom for the trainably retarded despite the cost exceeding the budget allocated for it this year by \$18,795.

The new classroom will cost \$63,795. CLS Asbestos also submitted the lowest tender for a new trainable retarded classroom at Orillia District Collegiate Vocational Institute. Its cost to the board is \$82,000, \$38,000 more than originally estimated.

But, the board's superintendent of Plant Doug Harvey stated in his report that it was essential to complete these classroom.

Other major projects approved by the board include:

The expenditure of \$103,333 on renovations for fire safety at Stayner Collegiate Institute. Two tenders were received with Don Ann Builders of Forest submitting the lowest. The Ministry of Education will allocate funding of approximately \$65,000 towards the cost of the project.

\$74,351 for a new restaurant training facility at Collingwood Collegiate Institute. The bid accepted from Qualecon Inc. of Collingwood was \$29,351 more than originally estimated but trustees decided to act on the project because a teacher had

been hired and students have enrolled in the program.

The problem with cost overruns prompted Barrie trustee Bill Paulin to call

for a running tally on its tenders and whether they are over or under projected estimates.

The keeping of a running tally would help trustees to

consider whether to proceed with cost over-runs.

The board's administrators will investigate the feasibility of the plan.
