Regulations suggested for marine owners

Black water, or toilet waste, cannot be flushed from a boat without first being taken to a marina with pump-out facilities.

It was suggested at other times during the evening that grey water should not be considered environmentally safe and should not be dumped in the bay.

Another source of concern throughout the evening was the number of boat slips suggested in the report. It recommends that the number be frozen at 1,800. Tony Lancia, the the president of Penetanguishene Chamber of Commerce and the Tiny Township Ratepayer's Association, said this was a "financial boon to marina owners" since those slips already in existence would increase in value since no more could be built.

"Let's face it, this creates a monopoly."

To rectify this alleged concentration of ownership, Lancia recommended that "a regulatory bylaw be set up" which would arbitrarily set a fixed rate at which marina owners

could rent boat slips.

"They (the marina owners) could raise the price to \$1,000 a month until they find someone willing to pay it."

Lancia's proposal was flatly rejected by Sullivan who said, "I don't think it's legal; it's far above a muncipalities power to tell a business man how much he can charge."

Picking up on this point, Carol Baker, the manager of the Midland Chamber of Commerce, said, "A lot of people think the committee is against commercial development. I don't think that's what the committee is all about."

Baker's principal concern was that the report suggests that boat's should no longer be used as allyear residences.

To this Peter Brasher replied that "a boat is for going places; it isn't a stationary residence."

"Says who?" asked

Sullivan assured the audience, "We're not sure everything in this policy is absolutely legally enforceable.'






