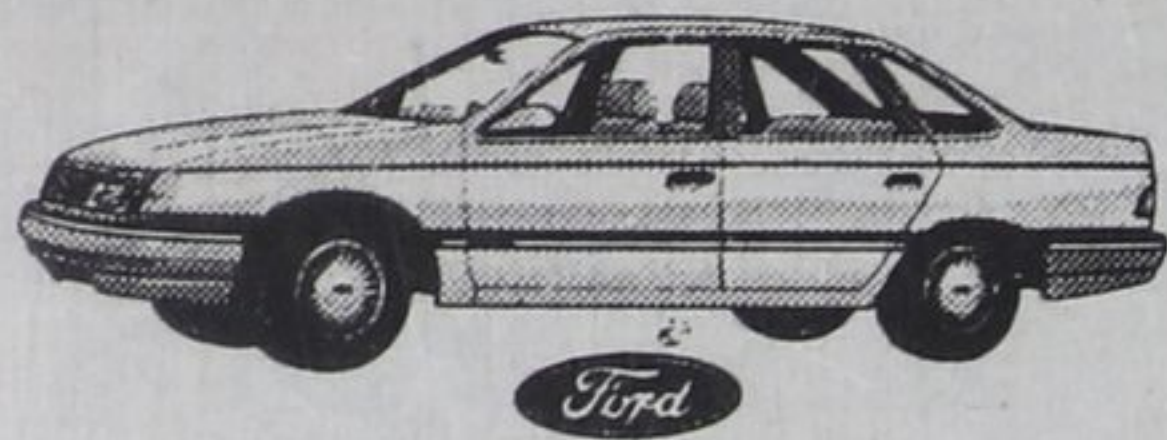
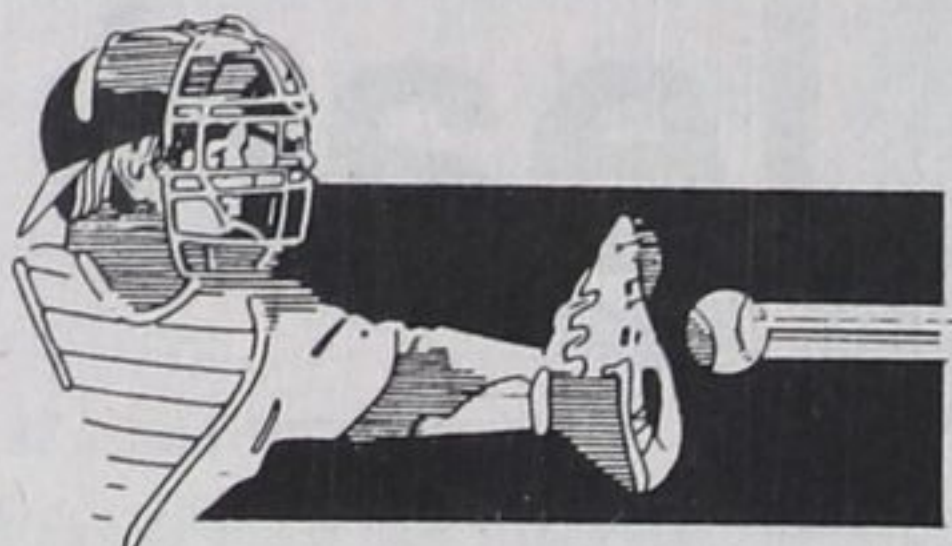

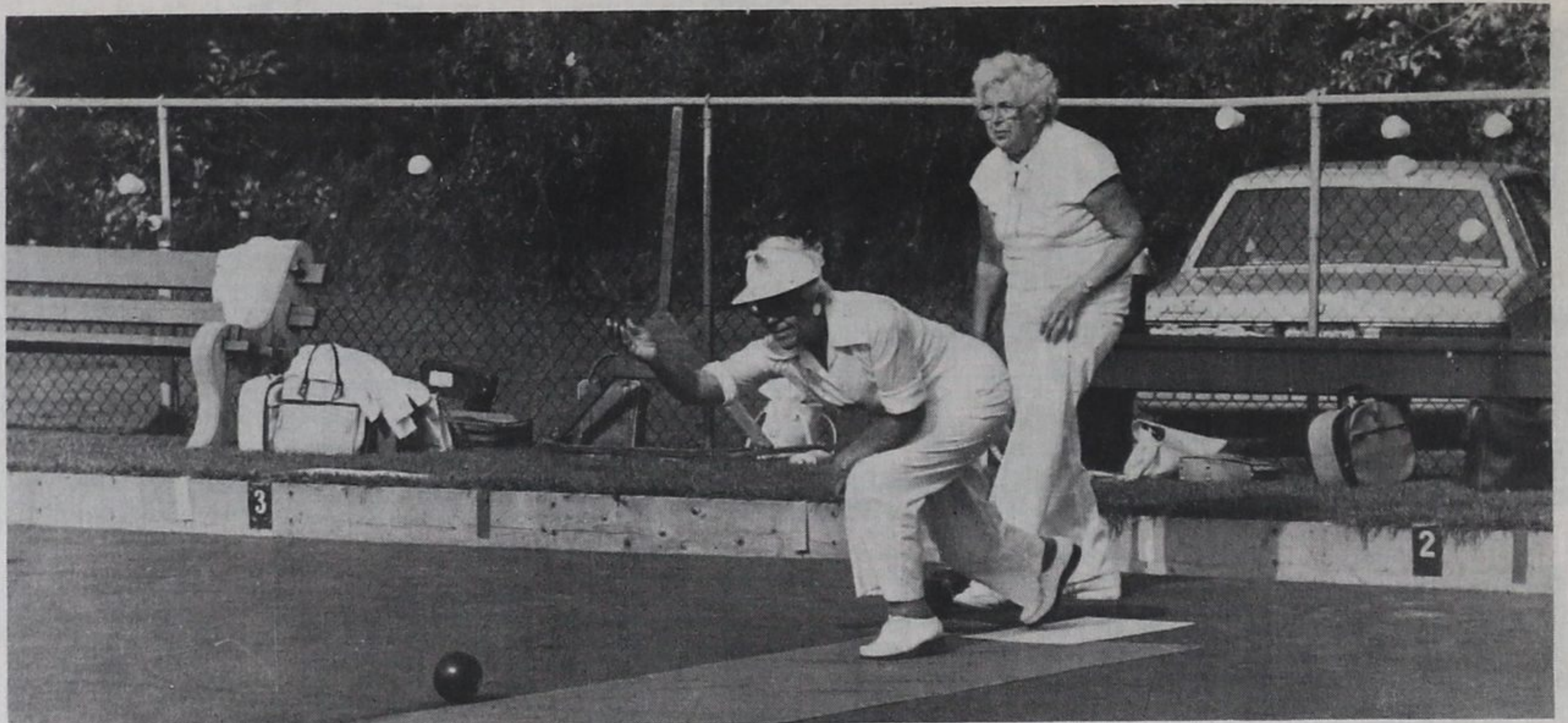

Lady bowlers from Stayner, Orangeville, and Orillia joined with Midland

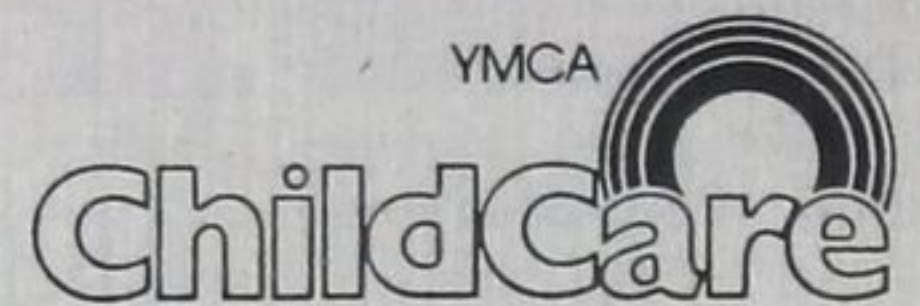
rinks for a total of ten teams. Two rinks emerged from the three draws with a perfect record of three wins, no losses.

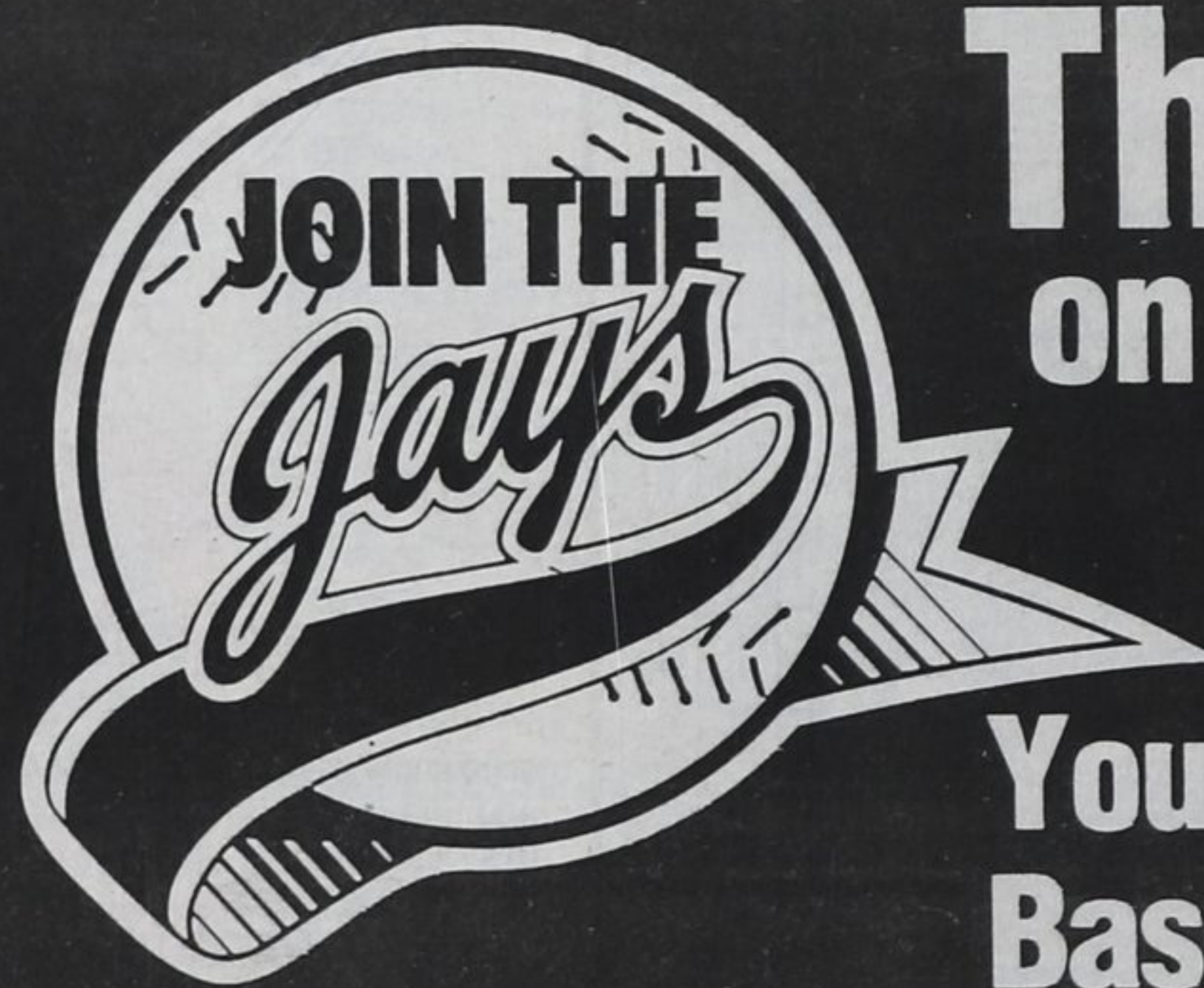
