## Make sure lights are well adjusted

Like most motorists, you have probably been dazzled by bright headlights from an oncoming vehicle. This is usually because one of the two lights is stronger than the other, the "dims" aren't dim enough or the light beams are maladjusted and shine directly in the eyes of on-coming drivers.

But how do you know if you're not guilty of this yourself? A trip to a service station with a special chart can verify whether or not

your lights are adequately adjusted. If not, the angle or luminosity can be corrected in a few minutes.

In the same vein, it is recommended that you get in the habit of regularly cleaning your headlights, especially in winter, when they are most always on.

After all, the greater the odds of being seen, the lower the risk of being in an accident.
