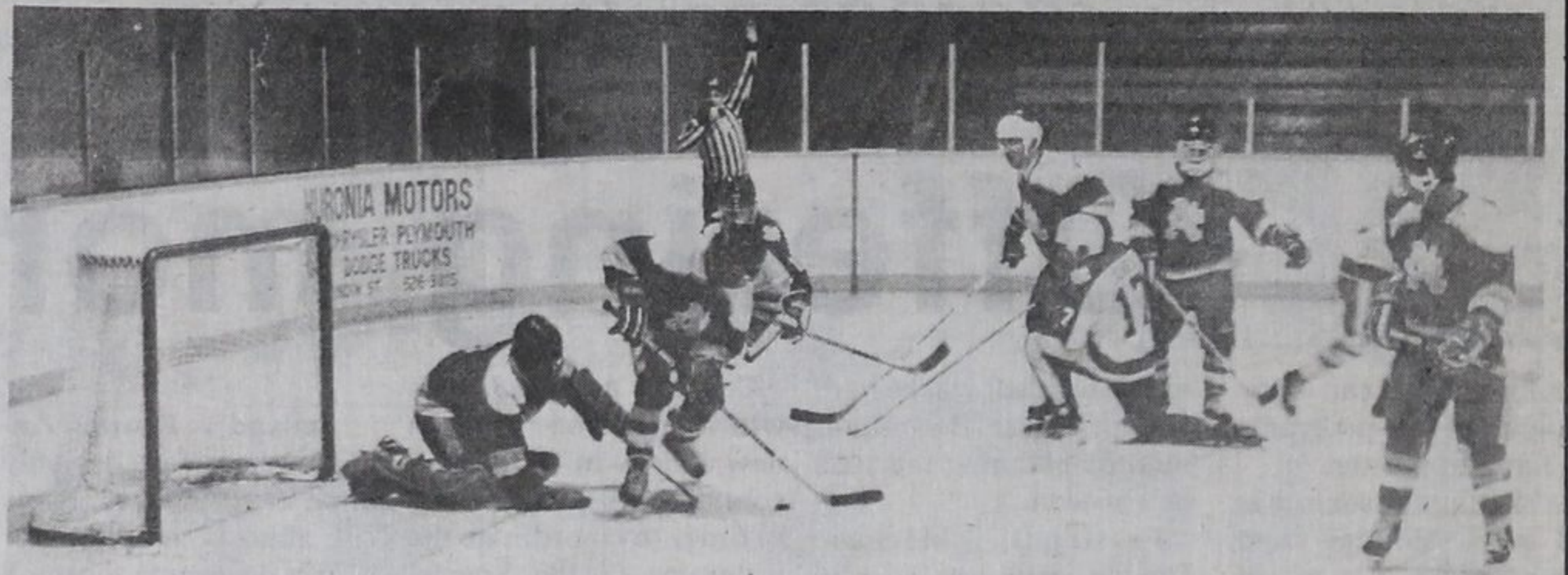

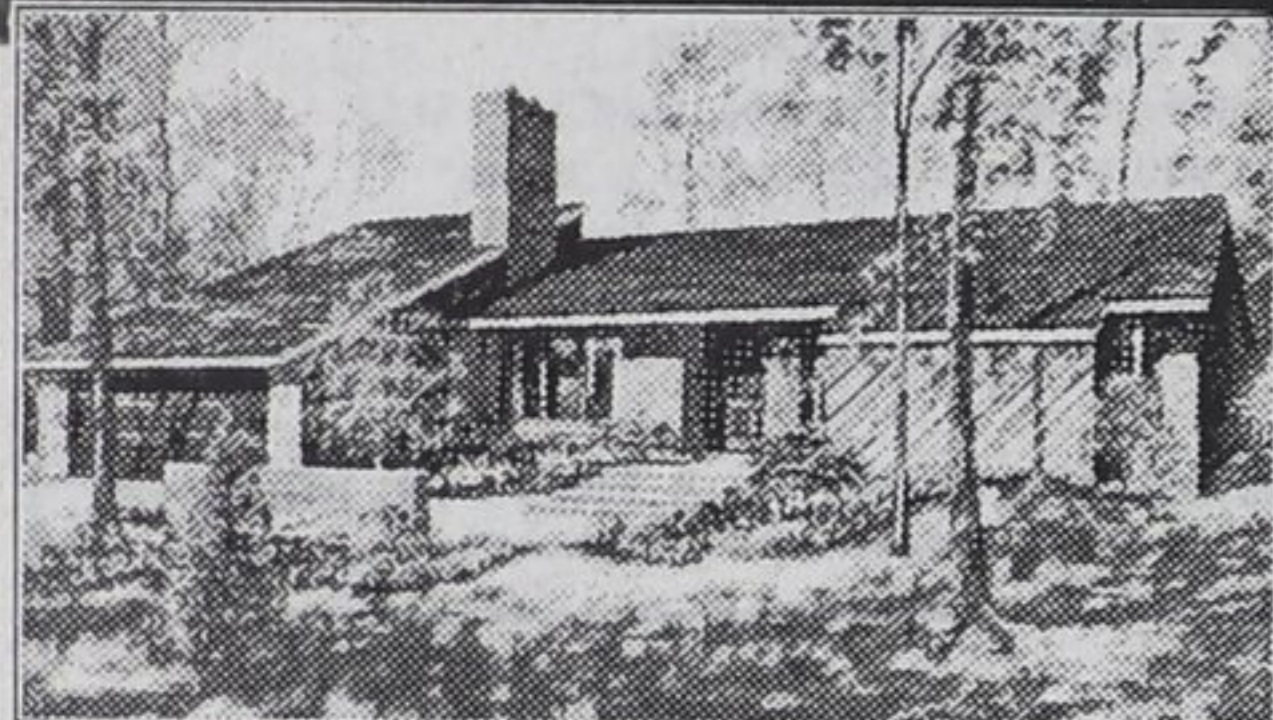
### Oldtimers tourney
