

Exchange students visit

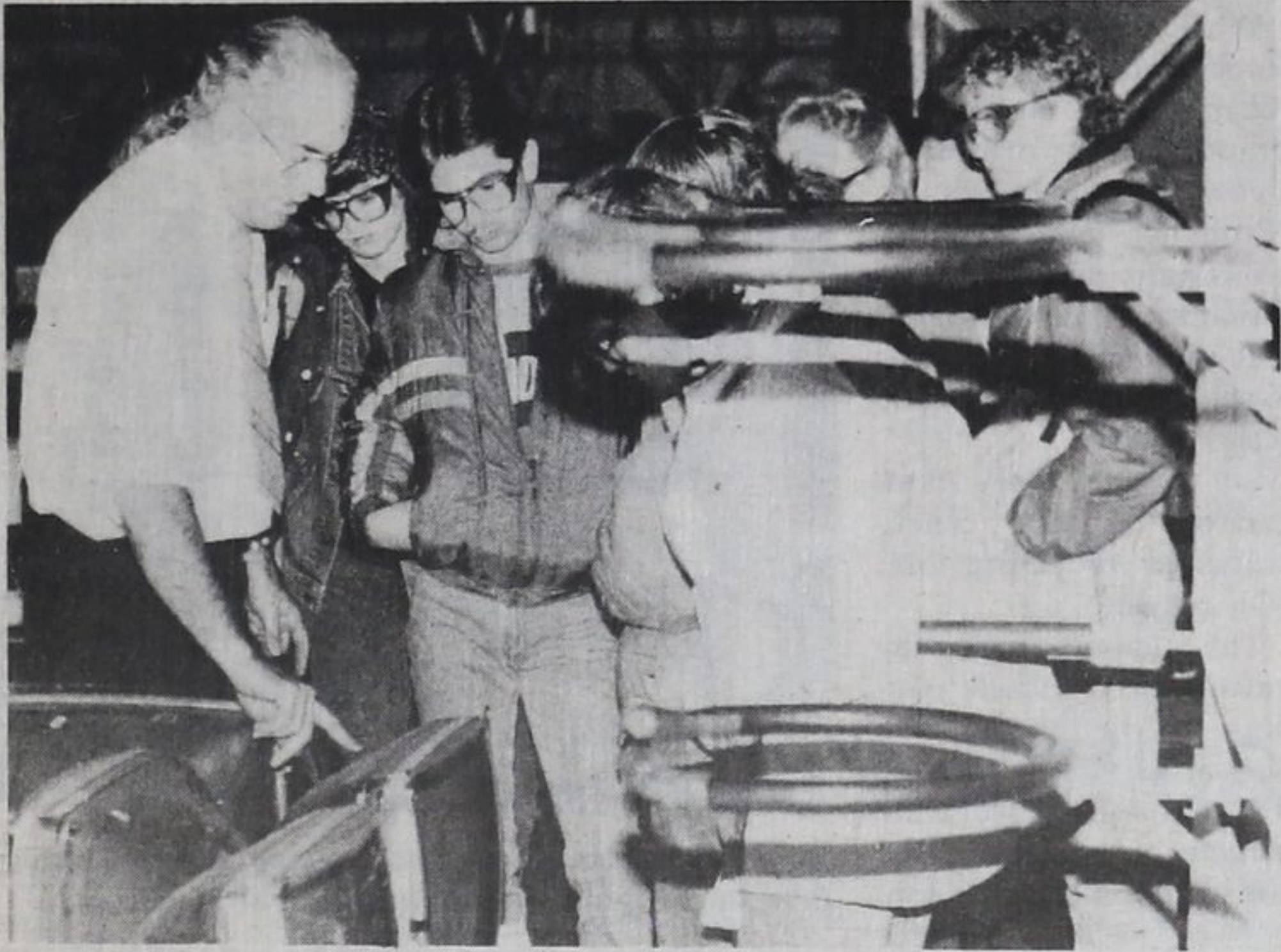
Twenty-four exchange students from Gravelbourg, Saskatchewan were treated to a tour of the Mitsubishi plant on Thursday.

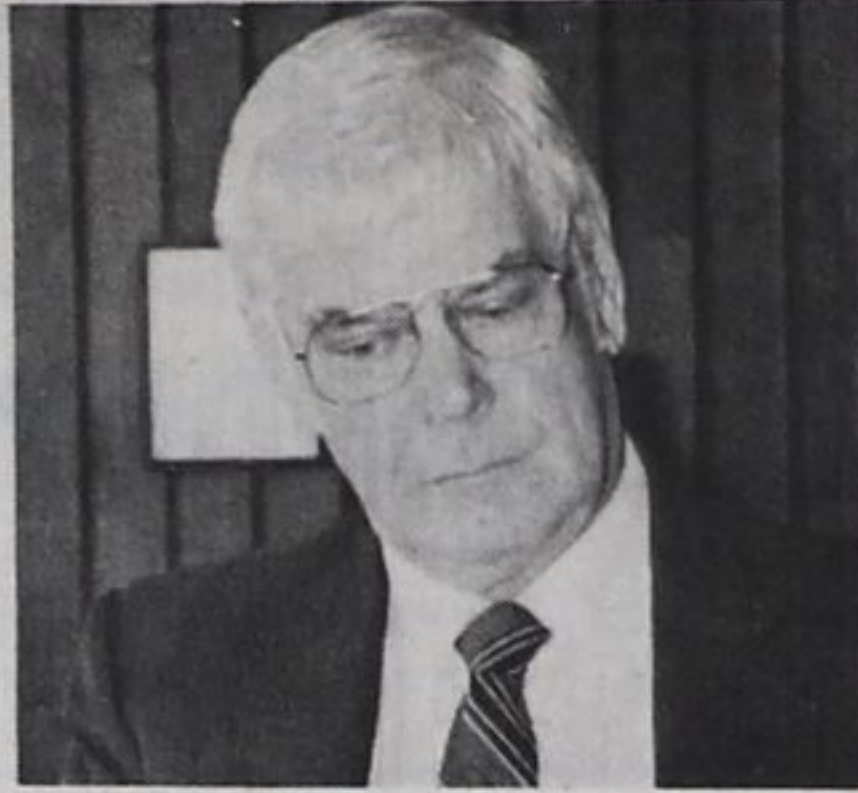
