### THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWN OF WASAGA BEACH PUBLIC NOTICE

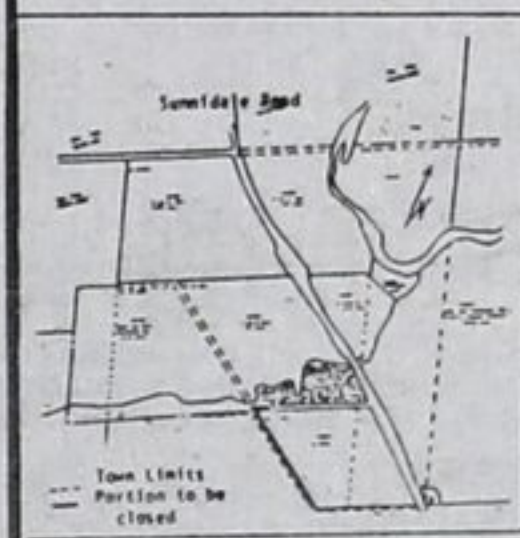

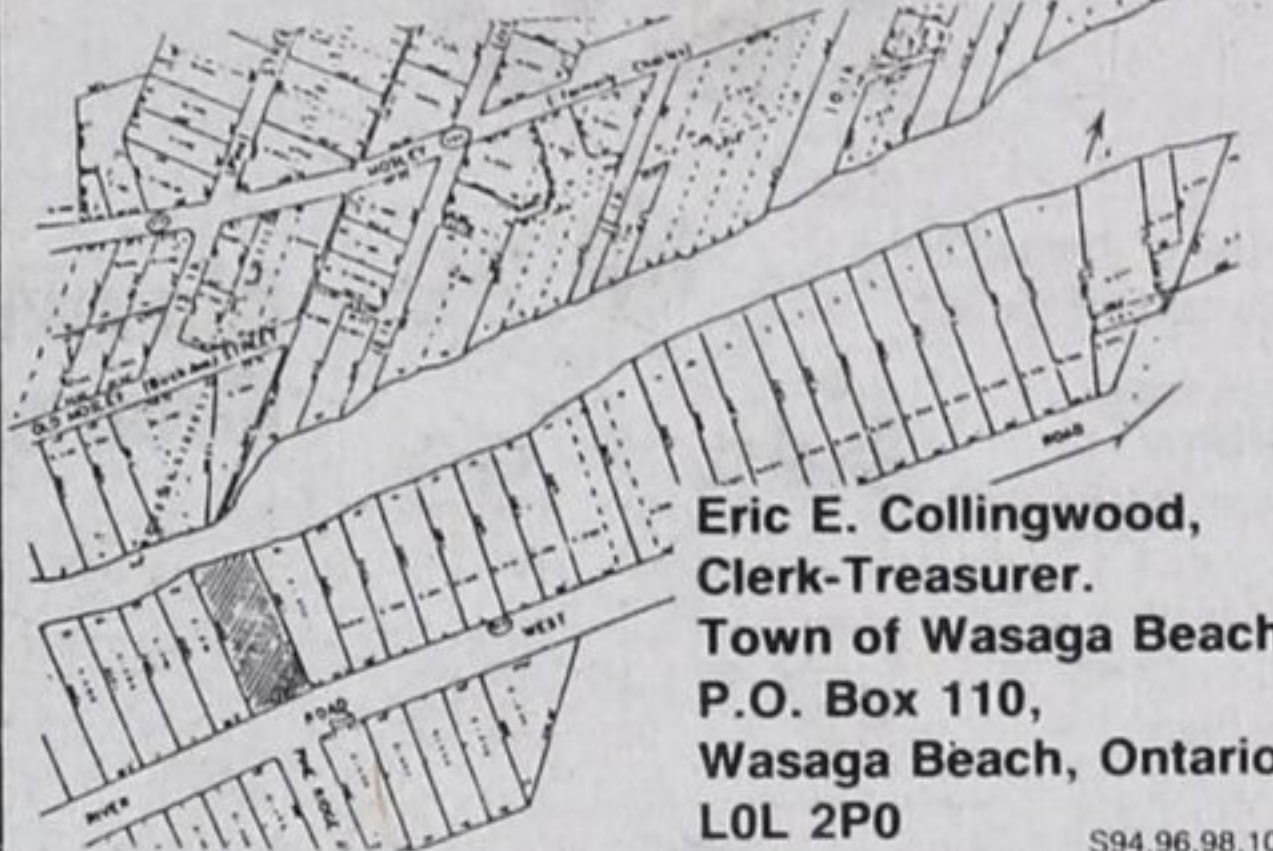

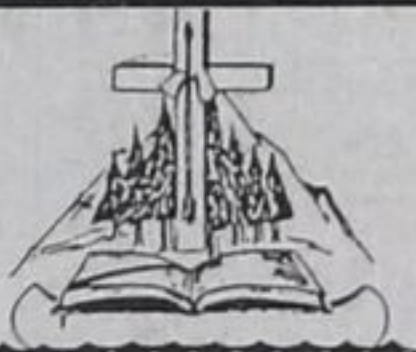
