

Crime stoppers needs an area representative

Crime Stoppers of Simcoe-Dufferin-Muskoka needs a board member from this area.

Board members are drawn from throughout the two counties and the District of Muskoka.

The Ontario Provincial Police started the Crime Stoppers program in Simcoe County in January, 1987.

The civilian board members decide which anonymous tipsters should be offered reward money.

The Simcoe-Dufferin-Muskoka program is one of the more successful of the 32 Crime Stoppers programs in Ontario, Const. Jim MacDonell says. "We're doing really good here."

Statistics are up significantly in 1988.

Midland-Penetanguishene and area currently is not represented on the board. Application to be the director can be made by calling Const. MacDonell at Crime Stoppers, 1-800-461-TIPS toll free, or 721-3333.

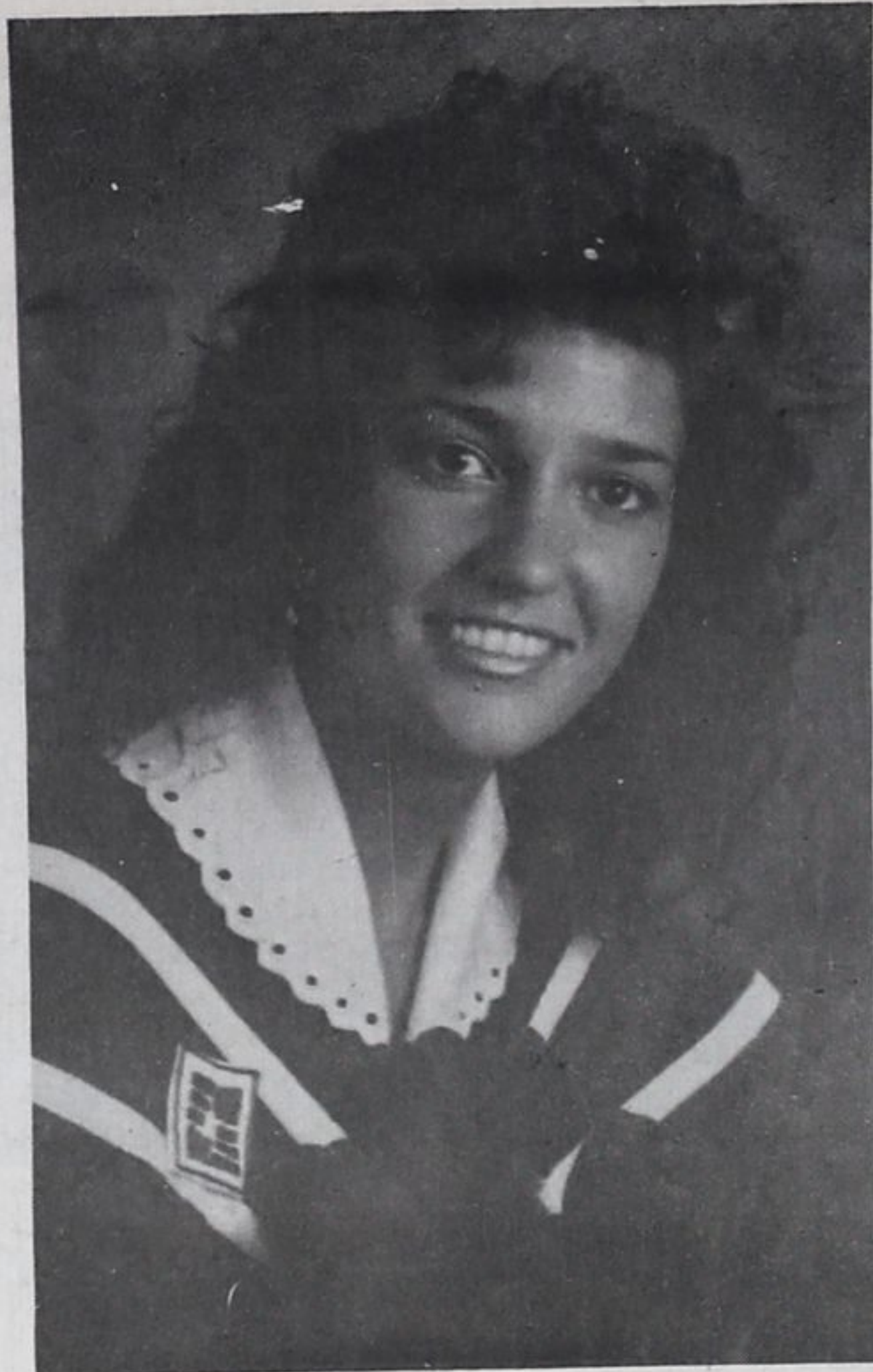
Through the first 11 months of 1988, two people have been arrested in connection with calls about crimes in Penetanguishene. Eleven calls were received. One case was solved, and \$640 worth of drugs seized.

Nine calls about crime in Midland were received. No arrests have resulted.

Eleven calls concerning crime in Midland OPP territory have resulted in one arrest and one case cleared. Drugs worth \$1,600 were seized.

Most of the calls to Crime Stoppers and most of the arrests have to do with crime in Barrie, Orillia and territory patrolled by the Orillia OPP.

Police from the participating police departments take turns answering the Crime Stoppers telephone. Officers from Midland and Penetanguishene each go to Barrie two days a month, MacDonell said.

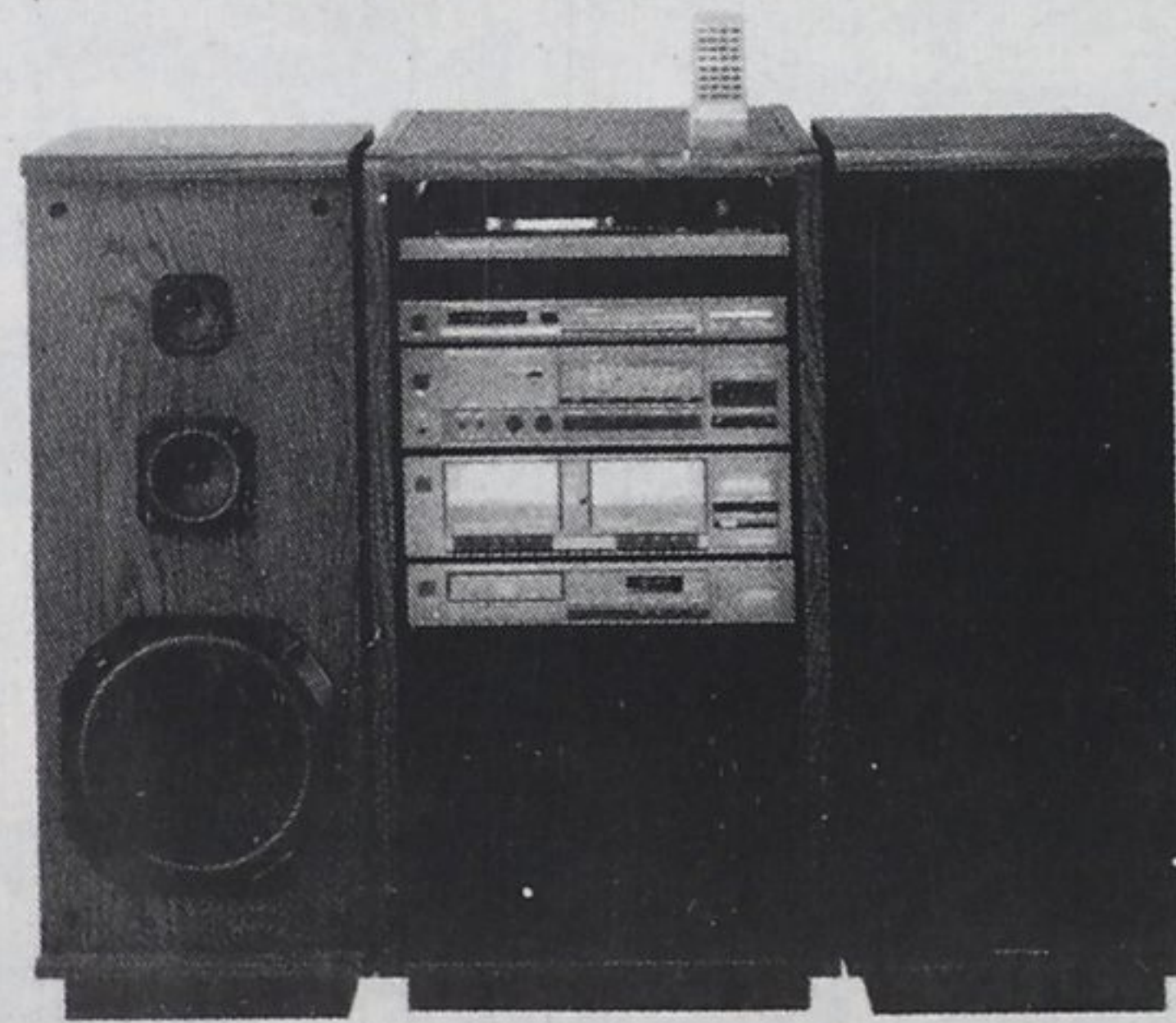
Huguenin reported that Tay has received the power to levy fines of up

to \$103.75 to anyone who contravenes its littering bylaw.

Permission was granted by the Criminal Division of the Provincial Court in Toronto under provincial legislation.

The township can take more serious offenders to court for fines up to \$2,000 maximum.

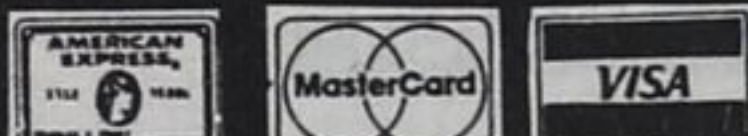
