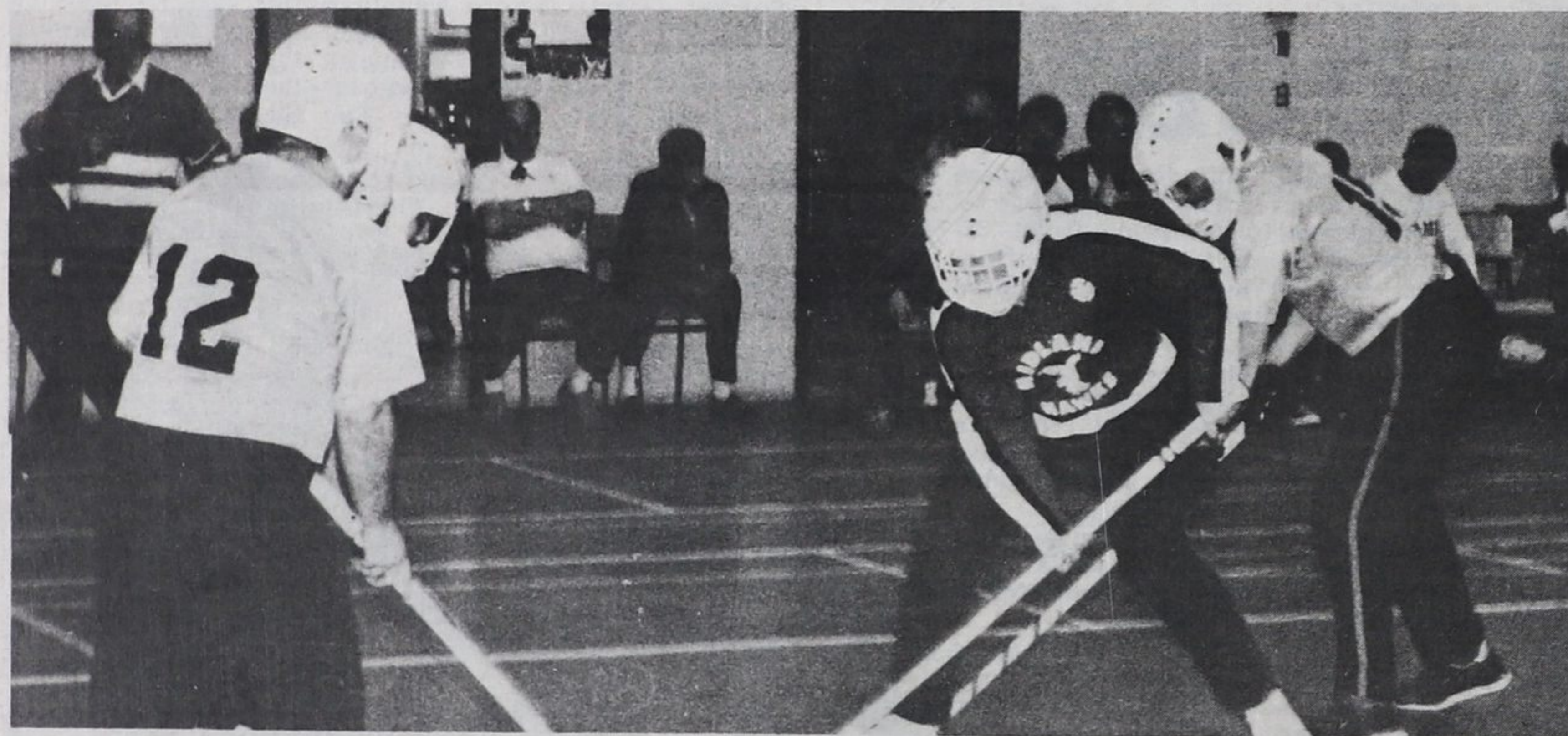




Tied up
