Penetang Midgets reach for silver

Penetanguishene midgets participated in the International Silver finals in Sarnia during the weekend and finished without a loss. However, they were denied the championship or even a chance at it as the team won a game and tied two, finishing out of the playoffs.

Penetang was matched with the eventual champion, Manitoulin in a Friday morning encounter.

The Panthers opened the scoring in the first but Penetang replied in the second with a marker from Brandon Spring assisted by Keith Robillard at the 4:42 mark. Greg Playne put Penetang in front four minutes later with a solo effort before Manitoulin knotted the count at 14:18. The teams skated through a scoreless third. Kerry Dupuis was sharp in the Penetang net.

In its next game, Penetang played Ripley to a 1-1 tie. Playne popped in passes from Derek Lotton and Chris Vallee 28 seconds into the contest for a quick Penetang lead. Ripley finally beat Claude Valle in the Penetang net late in the

third for a tie.

In its final game Saturday, Penetang doubled Bradford 4-2.

After a scoreless first, Brian Robillard clicked at 10:47 of the middle stanza unassisted only to have Bradford reply 36 seconds later. Playne gave Penetang a lead they wouldn't lose on a solo effort at 7:07 before Terry Bugg lifted the count to 3-1 with help from Brian Robillard.

Bradford pulled to within one at 3:07 of the third and tried to knot the score with an extra attacker in the dying minutes of the game. Brian Robillard scored into the empty net with 49 seconds showing on the clock.

Penetang finished in a three-way tie for third, only two points out of first and one out of second.

Manitoulin defeated Embrun 7-3 to win the international title.

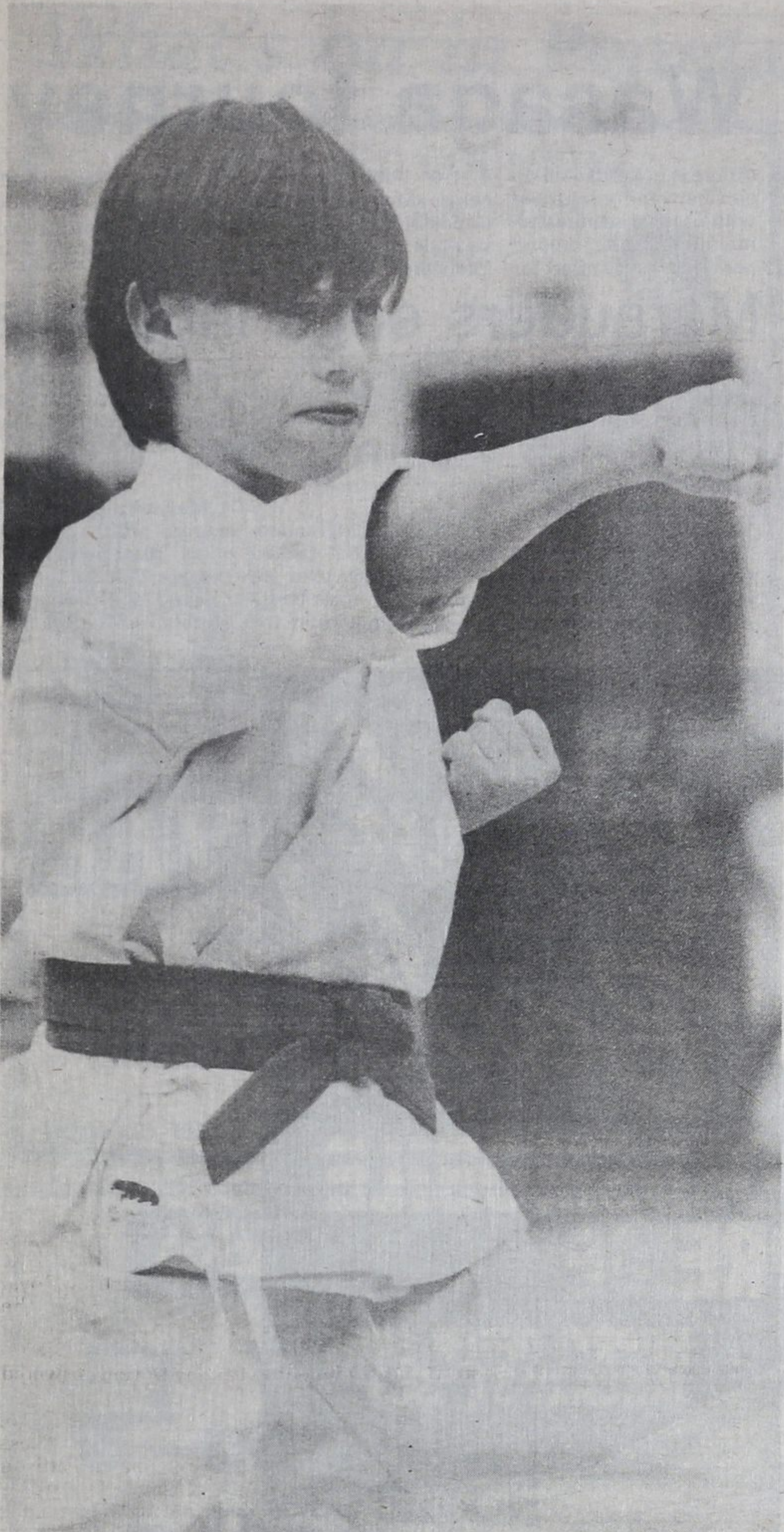
Penetang won the midget championship in 1975 while Midland Legion took top honors in 1977 and were runners-up in 1973.
