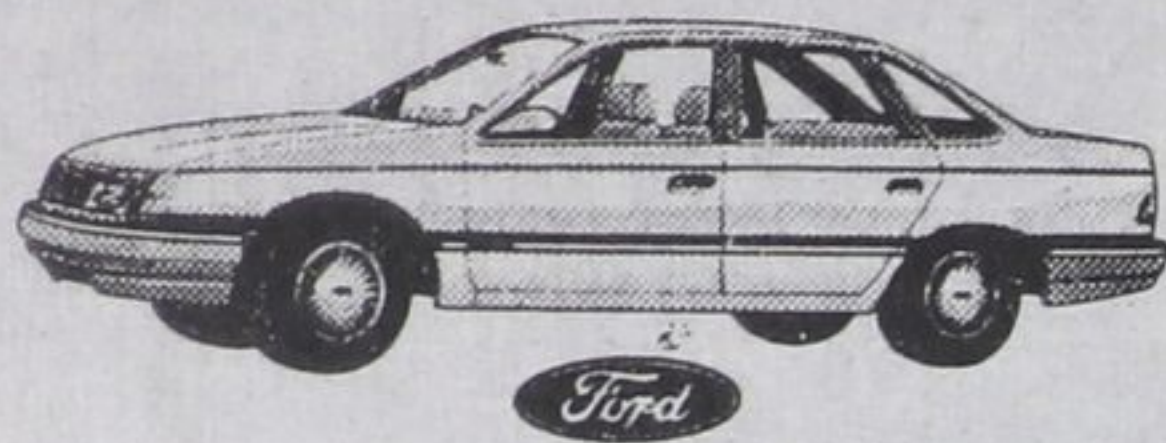

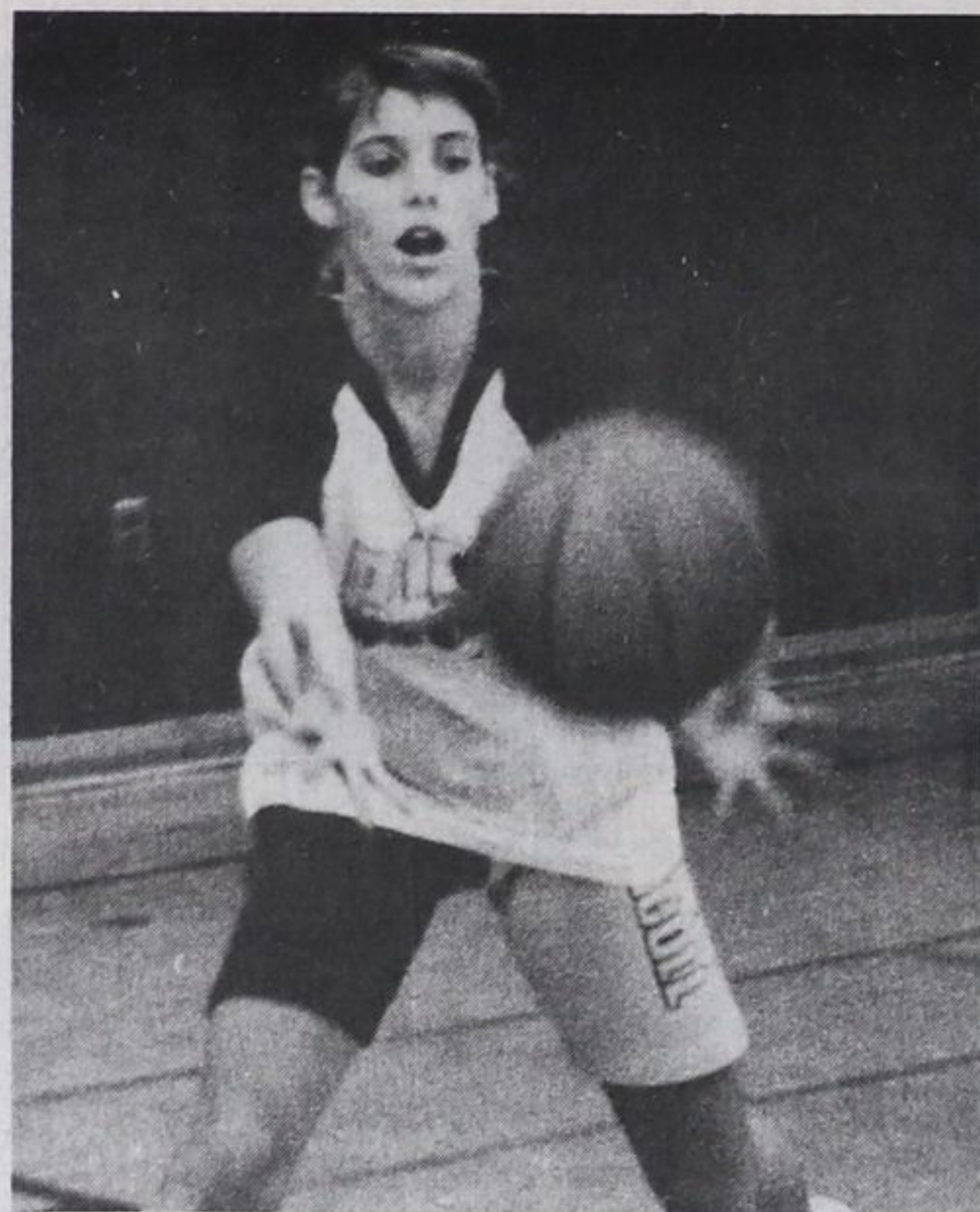

Huron Park Hornets win the Castex Cup

Huron Park Lady Hornets won the seventh annual Castex Cup Invitational Senior Elementary Girls Basketball tournament Saturday.

Huron Park rebounded from a 22-14 half time deficit to nip the host Lady Cavaliers 37-34 in the championship tilt.

Eight Area III teams took part in the double knockout tourney.

Castex started the day with a 56-15 win over St. Joseph. Jennifer Wright hooped 22 points to lead all scorers while Azure Dee Cassel clicked for 17 in the win.

Meanwhile Huron Park bested Port McNicoll 38-26. Wendy Mudde

scored 20 points in the win while Christy Lavin added 18. Jessica Brown struck for 15 for the Port.

Defending champions Regent Royals dropped a 44-30 decision to Victoria Harbour Hawks. Angela Woods recorded 14 points for the Hawks while Lindsay Jones netted 10 for Regent.

Huron Park tangled with Parkview in an afternoon encounter and ended with a 19-14 advantage. Mudde struck for 10 points as did Parkview's Krista Andrews.

Jennifer Wright clicked for 19 points to lead Castex to a 36-22 win over Victoria Harbour to qualify for the final.

Wright held a hot hand in the championship match counting 20 points fouling out of the match with two minutes to play. Christy Lavin picked up the slack and sank seven crucial foul shots in the second half for a 23 point contest. Lavin was named the tourney's MVP.

Huron Park were the runners-up last year to Regent while Castex have been in the bridesmaid role four times in the seven years of the tourney.

Next Saturday, Sacred Heart School will be hosting the Squires Classic beginning at 8:30 a.m.
