Huron Park girls won the Area III invitational basketball tournament for the second time in its 19-year history Saturday.

In first round action, Huron Park whipped Burkevale of Penetang 51-23 while Monsignor Castex drubbed defending champions Regent 61-25 and Victoria Harbour handled Sacred Heart 35-17. Other first round scores were, Port McNicoll 43 St. Joseph's 25, Parkview 39, St. Anne's 12 and Bayview 21, James Keating 29.

On the consolation side, St. Anne's got past Sacred Heart 20-14 while Bayview stopped Regent 39-20. St. Joseph rolled over Burkevale 53-22 and
