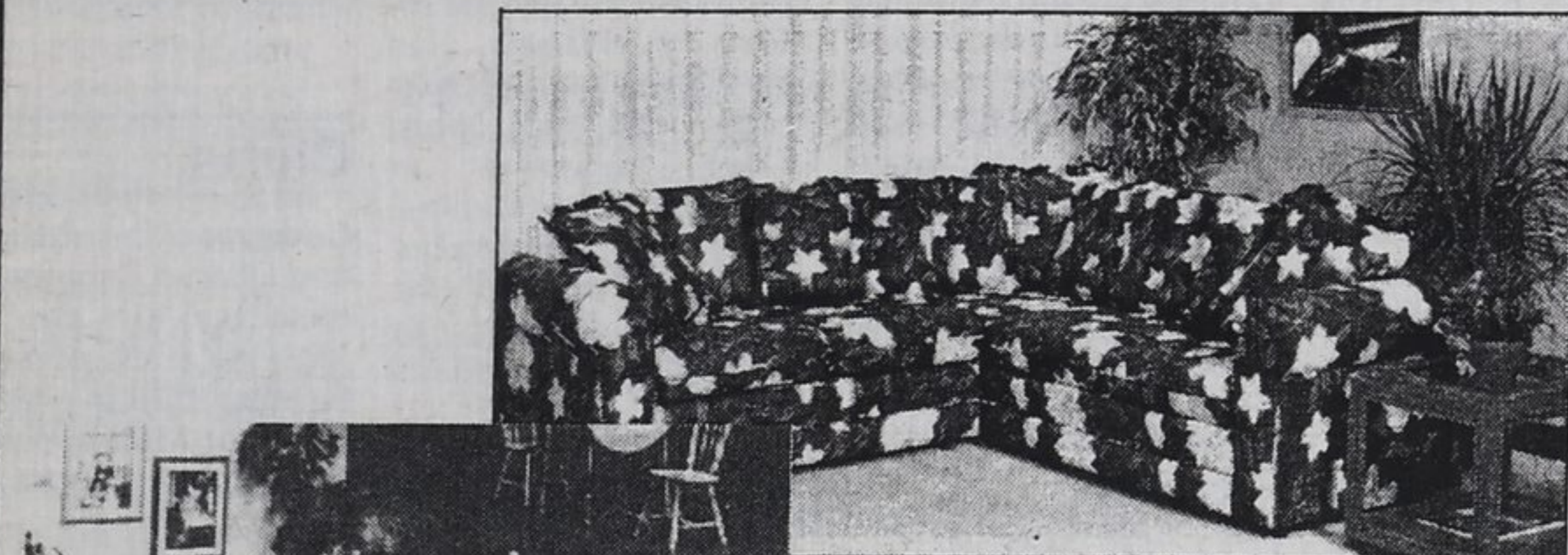

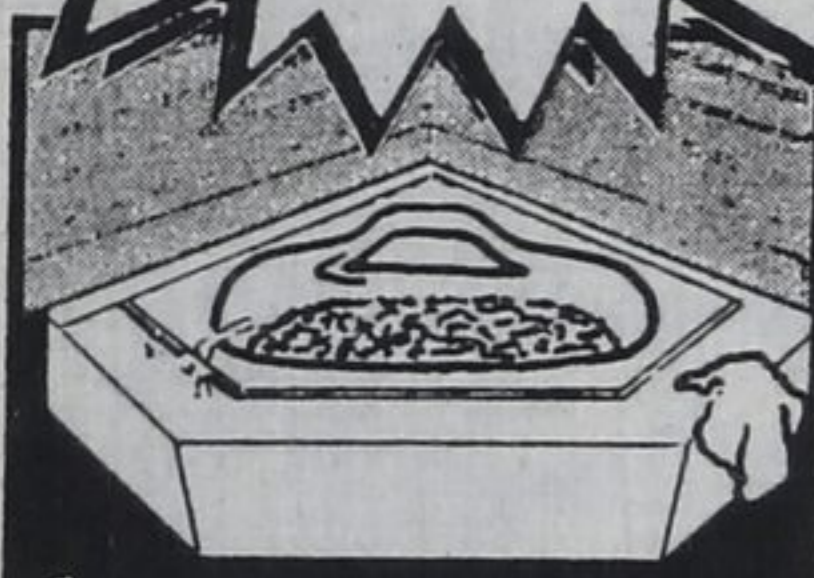

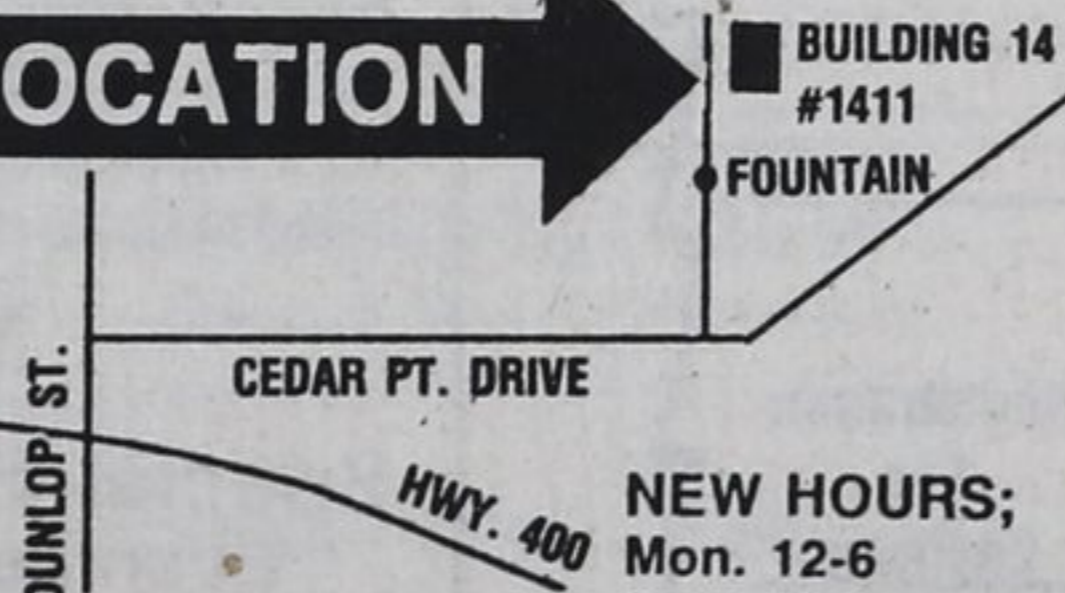

### ONTARIO TELEPHONE SERVICE COMMISSION NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING APPLICATION TO INCREASE LOCAL TELEPHONE SERVICE RATES

The Ontario Telephone Service Commission, pursuant to sections 6, 12 and 105 of the Telephone Act, has decided to hold a public hearing to review further evidence and submissions in regard to an application filed by **COLDWATER COMMUNICATIONS INC.** to increase local telephone service rates thereby generating additional revenues of **\$62,475**.

A public hearing will be held on Tuesday, March 21, 1989 at the Riverside Senior Citizen's Building, Main Street, Coldwater, Ontario, commencing at 7:30 p.m.
