come out if you don't, Charlie explains.

Chrissy cautions you have to wipe the tube when you're finished with it or the paint dries up. Kelly warns you can't squeeze the tube at the top, because it will get holes in it.

Junior notes the paint won't come off if you get it on yourself.

"Is it hard to do?" you ask. A chorus of 'yeahs' - and a few nonchalant "nos" answer your question.

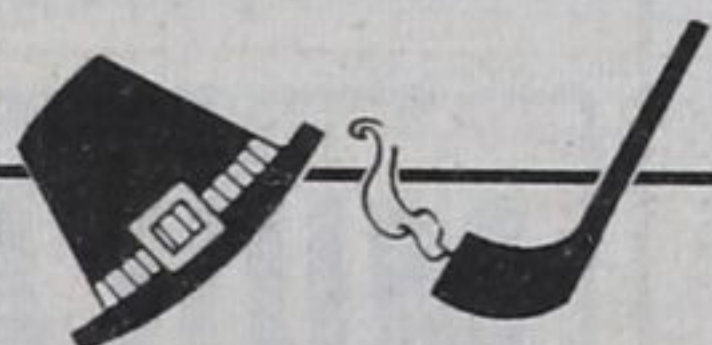
