13th. I further say, that at my trial at Merrittville, a witness named O. C. M'Leath, of Sandusky, an Attorney at Law, brought by the Crown, who proved that I was imprisoned in the County Jail, from the 1st of March, 1857, during which time he was the keeper of such jail.
